For two years the students at St. Mary's have been learning coding, building apps and learning digital design. Last year the 8th graders designed several items that could be printed on a 3D printer. The problem was that they had to send their designs out to get the items printed. The students made items ranging from phone holders to school logos. They also designed a chalice to give to Father Clement . He surprised the 8^{th} graders by using the chalice to hold the precious blood during the 8^{th} grade celebration Mass in May. This year, the students participating in the Makerspace classes and the middle school tech classes will be able to print their own designs on the school's new 3D printer thanks to the Knights of Columbus. The public will be able to see the 3D printer in action along with many other hands on demonstrations at the STEM Saturday Adventure.
