Navigating School through Covid 19

St. Mary's is one of the lucky schools. We are going face to face every day— if only for half a day. Our elementary students are getting all of their subjects at school with no on-line learning. The middle school gets all their subjects every day and live math and language arts three times a week. The full day is available on line when they are not in school. Although we are not livestreaming specials, our technology coordinator is putting Makerspace activities on line for all and some art classes will also be posted for students to participate in though not required. Distance learners will be expected to come into the school to test every two weeks to make sure they are keeping up. Our technology has been user friendly and things are moving smoothly. We have 25 distance learners and 125 in school.
