Saint Mary's Gearing up for a New Year

This year will be an important year for Saint Mary's. For the first time ever, Archdiocesan schools are being accredited by the Western Catholic Education Association. In the past Advanced Ed/North Central, which is the same group who accredits New Mexico's public schools, accredited Catholic schools. The WCEA process is similar although more stringent in its academic requirements of its schools. The WCEA will also look at how well Catholic identity is integrated into the school day. Introducing Saint Mary's Fabulous Teachers for 2015-16

PRE-K Teacher: New this year is <u>Ms. Elizabeth Cordova</u>. She has a degree in Early childhood education and has taught Pre-K-3rd grades at Belen Schools. We are excited to have her.

Kindergarten: <u>Ms. Kellie Lopez</u> is our returning kinder teacher. She has taught for Los Lunas Schools before coming to St. Mary's. Ms. Lopez does a great job getting our students ready for first grade.
