**Class 2 only:** Prelim 2 will be split into two sections:

**Section A** – Restricted ( horse / pony & rider combination not to have won 1<sup>st</sup> x 2 or more times in any previous OBRC dressage competitions either winter online or summer open dressage series.)

**Section B** – Open

**Entry information:** Special for online dressage competitions:

One horse can be ridden by two members in the same class.

**Prizes** Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> per class according to entries.

**Competition information.**

All the tests used for online dressage are the 2024 BD tests – which can be bought through the British Dressage **shop** via the [www.britishdressage.co.uk](http://www.britishdressage.co.uk) website.

You can buy a PDF download copy for £1 each – click on Test Type to order.

**Dressage Arena:** 20m x 40m arena with dressage markers in the correct positions.

Tests can be ridden on arenas: outdoors, indoors or on grass.

**Sending dressage test videos**

Videos should be sent via WhatsApp no 07836 608921

Any problems speak to Diane who can will give you an alternative method.

**Each video submitted must not have been previously judged either at a dressage competition or another online competition.**

**Dress & tack code.**

\* Riders do not need to wear competition dress.

\* **Avoid wearing black clothes** ie jumpers / coats as it is very hard for the judge to see you at the bottom of arena especially on dark or very sunny day.

\* Gloves are not compulsory . Lighter the clothing the better.

\* Dressage legal tack & bits this includes NO martingales or boots on horses.

**Dressage score sheets** will be emailed out after judging & sheets have been marked.

The Judge's score sheets paper copies & rosettes will be posted out to each rider.

**Results** will be published on website & facebook pages once tests have been judged.

**Test riding tips for future training and competitions.**

Very useful to have the marked paper score sheet available to look at while watching your video to see how the judge's comments & marks reflect with movements.

This is a useful way to continue training through the winter, practice riding different tests and gain helpful feedback from experienced dressage judges.
