The Blue team finished in 1st place which was fantastic: Louise Bennett, Carol Fletcher, Louise Pusey, Charlotte Rollinson.

Our Gold team only sadly had three members, but they still all did well finishing in 7th place: Katie Penn, Anka Taylor, Anna Collins. Julie Fleming won both of the BRC Prelim tests with a score of 75%.

Elizabeth Rollinson for 1st place in novice +BD points. Kirsty Scott 1st place in the elementary, Louise Riley-Hunt 1st in medium test and 2nd place in advanced medium class.

Presentations of the Challenge Trophies and special awards

DEERHUNTER TROPHY Area dressage Prelim, Novice

Winner: Alison Dippenaar & Jazz

Alison did very well at the winter qualifiers finishing 2nd place in prelim test with 72%.

Winter championships rode in the prelim test finishing 2nd place with over 70% score.



MAURICE ESSEX DRESSAGE CUP Area tests: Elementary, Medium, Advanced Medium

Winner: Tamsin Morris & Khadira

Qualified at winter areas to compete in the Championships at Arena UK – finishing in 2nd place. Qualified at the summer dressage & competed at Lincoln summer championship in 6th place in elementary & 8th place medium.

IAN CRIPPEN SHIELD Area winter & summer show Jumping 60cm, 70cm

Winner: Louise Pusey & Billy Whizz.

They jumped two double clears in the 60cm & 70cm classes at the area qualifiers. Louise was invited to compete at the Summer SJ championships as individual in 60cm & part of the 70cm team. There they jumped two double clears in both heights over very different courses.

ROSSLARE SHOW JUMPING TROPHY - Area 80cm, 90cm, 100cm

Winner: Anka Taylor & Ella who jumped a double clear in the 80cm class at the winter SJ, finishing in 2nd place against 45 other riders.

Coney Spurs Trophy – Dressage to music

Winner: Elizabeth Etchells & Maurice who finished in 2nd place in the Novice OBD points in January 2025 & were invited to compete at the championships in April where they won the championship class with 71% out of 21 riders.

Galway Rose Cup combinations starting out at intro dressage level

Winner: Louise Bennett & Jack.

They competed in our winter online competitions in 2024-25 series, giving them confidence to compete in the area Q in October in finished 6th place. At the December Area 6 Q Louise & Jack won the intro test out of 10 riders & helped the blue team win.



HEATHER EDWARDS TROPHY

C T / Combined challenge / Arena Eventing

Winner: Alexa Iona-Smith & Callie.

The pair competed as an individual in the combined training qualifier in June at BCA. Won their Prelim test & 80cm with a good dressage mark & clear SJ. Competed at the CT Championships & won her arena class championships which was fantastic.



ONE DAY EVENT CUP - Horse Trials

Winner: Elizabeth & Maurice who normally just compete in the dressage & SJ. They thought they would enter the HT. Finishing in 3rd place with an invitation to the champs.

Championships: they rode a brilliant test & jumped CR. XC course was twisty & hilly. But only one run out, but they finished which is the important part.

BEST DRESSAGE TEAM – 2025

Open team members: Janine Modder, Jane Bancroft, Charlotte Rollinson, Kirsty Scott. Won at the Area 6 team qualifiers at Wellington Riding in December 2024. The team were invited to compete at the winter championships at Arena UK in April 2025. All rode brilliant tests and the final scores were announced our team members had finished in 2nd place out of 33 teams, which was fantastic.

BEST JUMPING TEAM – 2025

70cm Show Jumping team: Louise Pusey, Gina Elliott, Ellie Rose & Julie Fleming competed at Area 6 summer SJ Qualifiers at BCA and won the competition.

This was brilliant and exciting as the team were invited to compete at the summer SJ championships in Lincoln in late August 2025.

Unfortunately Julie's horse Clover was struggling with the scary fillers, so kindly stepped back & Hannah Brookfield took her place at championships. They all jumped very well over two tough and challenge courses to finish in 9th place from 22 teams which was amazing

Special Award

Liz Rollinson and Rebel support & compete in the summer dressage & winter series. Rebel is quite cheeky as he will shy at anything and challenges Liz to get the best from him. The pair enjoy competing in DTM but have to ride the novice tests which are more challenging.

With new music only ridden through once before, they competed in area 6 DTM qualifier.

Despite Rebel spooking at the big dressage letters & judge's car - Liz rode a good safe test. When the results were announced they won the class & qualified for the championships.



Jumping improvement

Gina bought Bubby in 2024, attended pole clinics & some of the Georgie Dalton clinics. Competed for the club in the Summer SJ Q's at 60cm & 70cm teams & the Combined Training team at prelim dressage & 70cm. At the CT championship Gina & Buddy stepped up a level to fill a place in the team, but needed to jump the 80cm course which they coped with well.

Progressive improvement

Winner: Katie Penn & Kai.

Kai can be a challenge as he gets very tense in new situations. Sensibly they started out with winter online dressage, then braved the Area 6 intro Q in 2024 at Wellington. In 2025 they came to summer dressage series, joined in some of our clinics away from home and braved Wellington area dressage Q in December competing in the two tests. Now competing in this winter dressage series. Kai has really improved and is gaining more confidence.

HORSE HEAD TROPHY - To the horse or pony who has joined events & clinics

Winner: Lilly and her rider Anne Jermey. Lilly is now 21 years old, she has attended lots of clinics, competed in the summer evening dressage, online dressage, jumped in the 40cm BRC club jumping and won the 40cm championship.
