Dressage test: **BD Novice 28 (2008)**
Unlimited Novice pts. Up to 35 Elementary Pts.
0 pts at Medium or above.

Class: Senior Winter Dressage Novice section.
Dressage test: **BD Novice 34 (2009)**
Unlimited Novice pts. Up to 35 Elementary Pts.
0 pts at Medium or above.

Class : Senior Winter Dressage Elementary section.
Dressage test: **BD Elementary 42 (2008)**
Unlimited elementary Pts. Up to 35 Medium Pts.
0 Points at Advanced Medium or above.

Class: Senior Open Dressage Teams
Team of 4 riders to ride:
1x Prelim 14 test, 1x Novice 28 test,
1x Novice 34 test , 1x Elementary 42 test.

Class : Winter PYO tests for individuals
Mixed class Juniors & seniors.
Dressage test: BD Medium 63 (2002)
Unlimited Medium Pts & up to 35 total Pts at Adv Medium.

or

Advanced Medium 90 (2012)
Unlimited Advanced Medium Pts. Up to 50 Pts at Advanced or above.

Rider's eligibility: Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline
in the last 5 calendar years.

Important notice on entry fees for Area 6 qualifiers.

Due to the COVID -19 pandemic this year the club has not been in a position to organise the usual number of fundraising events to support members with entry fee costs such as paying the BRC pre- entry fees for Area qualifiers. Until such time as the club is able to raise adequate funds again members will be asked to pay the BRC Pre- entry fees please.

Pre- entry fees:

* Part of a team of 4 riders – cost @ £8 per rider.

* Entering as an Individual @ £10 per rider.

Main entry fee for everyone @ £18 each.

The total of both entry fees will need to be paid to OBHRC bank account by no later than **Wednesday 16th September 2020** to secure your class entries.

Protective headwear rules and Aqua hat tags. Rules on Flu vaccinations & microchips

Note from organisers: as there will not be paramedics in attendance, any rider who falls from a horse, anywhere on the show ground, will not be allowed to remount. No refunds will be given in this situation.

Please can members include the information below with the passport details.

Part of the entry forms that are filled in on member's behalf for this Area 6 qualifying competition includes the horse's competition details i.e: List BD points won to date at the level of test being ridden at intermediate dressage competition.

Please can you check class tests & make sure you & your horse are eligible to compete in the tests.

Note:

If you have entered the Area 6 Arena Eventing you will not be required to send in your horse's passport & details as this will be on the OBHRC files.

Flu Vaccinations and microchips

All horses must be up to date with influenza vaccinations in line with the rule G7 in the current BRC handbook. The most recent vaccination must be within 6 months and 21 days of the competition i.e after the 21/03/2020.

As of 1st October it is compulsory for all horses to be microchipped.

Passports must travel with horses and there may be spot checks on the day.

Since COVID-19 there are now big changes in the Area 6 Q competitions & how they are organised.

One new change is instead of you having to your horse's passport checked at the secretary's office on the competition day.

All passports are to be checked well before the day of the competition by the RC Team managers of your own riding club.

Official Area 6 Steward has sent us an excel format to use for our club's vaccination database and Sally & I are now responsible for checking eligibility for all the horses and ponies that compete are area qualifiers & championships.

Once members have paid their entry fees to OBHRC bank account by 16th September. Please can you follow the steps below:

Step 1 : Can you check that you horse's Flu vaccinations are up to date & within the time frame for the intermediate dressage on Sunday 11th October.

Step 2: Can each member photocopy or take a photo of your horse's passport and email all the information below to me: dianehunt@ymail.com

Requirements: A picture of the inside front cover of passport with horse's name. Passport number & microchip number.

Then I need pictures of the Flu vaccination with dates from the present time date back to where the vet has written 1: which is first primary injection , 2: second primary 3: first booster & the dates in between up to the most recent date.

All horses Flu vaccinations will need to return to the 6 months & 21 days ruling as of 1st October 2020.

No flu injection should be done any later than 8 days before the competition date.
