Details of classes, eligibilities for teams & individuals.

Please can you check class tests & make sure you & your horse are eligible
to compete in the tests.

Senior Dressage Teams with team of 4 riders to ride:

1x Prelim 14, 1x Novice 27, 1x Novice 34, 1x Elementary 44.

(All team members are automatically entered as individuals in team test ridden)

Members can enter another test class as well as an individual.

Senior Winter Dressage Prelim class

Dressage Test: **BD Prelim 14 (2006)**

Horse eligibility BD points: Unlimited Prelim pts.

Up to 35 Novice Pts. 0 pts at Elementary

(Horses cannot have competed in elementary or above in same competition year for BD or BRC)

Senior Winter Dressage Novice class

Dressage test: **BD Novice 27 (2007)**

Horse eligibility BD points: Unlimited Novice pts.

Up to 35 Elementary Pts. 0 pts at Medium or above.

Senior Winter Dressage Novice class .

Dressage test: **BD Novice 34 (2009)**

Horse eligibility BD points: Unlimited Novice pts.

Up to 35 Elementary Pts. 0 pts at Medium or above.

Senior Winter Dressage Elementary section.

Dressage test: **BD Elementary 44 (2002)**

Horse eligibility BD points: Unlimited elementary Pts. Up to 35 Medium Pts.

0 Points at Advanced Medium or above.

Winter Pick a Test for Senior & Junior mixed individuals

Dressage test: **BD Medium 71 (2002)**

Horse eligibility BD points: Unlimited Medium pts, up to 35 pts at Adv Med or above.

Dressage test: **Advanced Medium 93 (2004)**

Horse eligibility BD points: Unlimited Adv Med Pts. Up to 50 Pts at Adv or above.

Rider's eligibility: Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline
in the last 5 calendar years are not permitted.

Please note:

All riders and horse / pony combinations are welcome to compete in the winter intermediate dressage qualifiers 2021.

The BRC eligibility requirements listed on the classes refers only to the those horses and ponies who are register and compete in British Dressage competitions.

Wellington Riding facilities

Please read all the information flu boosters & microchip requirements

Updated flu booster vaccinations rules 1st September 2021.

All horses must be up to date with influenza vaccinations in line with the rule G7 on page 27 of the BRC handbook 2021 for the initial course of 1st and 2nd primary injections and 1st booster dates.

As of 1st September 2021 the BRC have changed to flu vaccination booster.

New rules

Annual 12 month vaccinations are needed for all Area qualifying competitions and Championships.

Please remember that this is just for British Riding Club's competitions. Other associations may have a different requirements for flu vaccinations.

Microchips

As of 1st October 2020 it is compulsory for all horses to be microchipped.
Passports must travel with horses and there may be spot checks on the day.

Note from organisers: As there will not be paramedics in attendance, any rider who falls from a horse, anywhere on the show ground, will not be allowed to remount. No refunds will be given in this situation.
