**Details of classes, entry fees for teams & individuals.**

Please read the schedule carefully & check through all the eligibilities & restrictions for both horses & riders in each class.

Open to Seniors members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year.

Restriction in all classes: Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in relevant discipline in the last 5 year calendar can not compete.

**Class 1 : Intro Dressage to Music**

Test: BD Intro Freestyle to Music (2016) Please note 20m x 40m arena for **intro** ( [London & South Qualifier only](#) )

**Restrictions:** NOT open to those competing in BD / BRC Novice classes or above.

**Class 2: Prelim Dressage to Music**

Test: BD Prelim Freestyle to Music (2016)

( **B** ) **Senior National Qualifier** and London & SE Qualifier.

**Horse eligibility:** Unlimited BD Prelim points.

\*\* No BD points at Novice or above.

Horse cannot have competed in elementary or above in the same competition year BD or BRC.

**Rider eligibility:** FBHS, BHSI, BHSII qualification not to have been within the past ten years.  
Riders cannot have competed at BE Novice or Elementary dressage or above in the current year or previous calendar year BD or BRC.

**Class 3: Novice Dressage to Music (Zero BD points)**

**Test: BD Novice Freestyle to Music (2019 )**

( **A** ) **Senior National Qualifier** \* **Zero Points Section:** and London & SE Qualifier.  
Horses down graded by BRC to zero points are eligible.

**Horse eligibility:** Unlimited BD Prelim points.

\*\* No points at Novice or above.

Horses cannot have competed in elementary or above in same competition year BD / BRC

**Rider's eligibility:**

Riders cannot have competed at BE Novice or Elementary dressage or above in the current or previous calendar year BD or BRC.

**Class 3: Novice Dressage to Music ( with BD points )**

( **B** ) **Senior National Qualifier** and London & SE Qualifier

**Horse eligibility:** Unlimited Novice points. Up to 35 Elementary points.

\*\* No points at Medium or above.

**Class 4: Elementary Dressage to Music ( National Qualifier & L&SE Q )**

**Test: BD Elementary Freestyle to Music (2019)**

**Horse eligibility:** Unlimited Elementary points and up to 35 Medium points.

\*\* No points at Advanced Medium or above.

**Class 5: Medium /Advanced Medium Dressage to Music (National Qualifiers)**

**Test: PYO BD Medium / Advanced Medium Freestyle to Music (2016)**

**Horse eligibility:**

**Medium:** Unlimited Medium points. Up to 35 Advanced Medium points or above.

\*\* Riders may choose which test they are better suited to Medium or Advanced Medium

**Advanced Medium:** Unlimited Advanced Medium points, up to 50 total points at Advanced or above. No Rider restrictions.

\*\* Riders can enter both Medium & Advanced Medium tests.

**Class 6: BRC Pairs Dressage to Music Freestyle Novice Level ( 2018 )**

**Horse eligibility:** Unlimited Novice points. Up to 35 Elementary points.

\*\* No points at medium or above.

**Class 7: BRC Open Pairs Dressage to Music Freestyle Elementary Level**

**(2018)** No restrictions.

**Flu Vaccination Rules 2021.**

The BRC Flu vaccinations require all horses to have had a booster within 6 months and 21 days of DTM competition date, but not within 7 days prior to the 21<sup>st</sup> August.

Please check your horse passport dates to make sure they are after 31/01/21 and either before the 15/ 08/ 21 or within the 6 months and 21 days covering the 21<sup>st</sup> August.

**Important Note:**

All passports dates are now checked by the Team Managers of your Riding Club.

Passports must travel with your horse and there are spots checks at the Area competitions.

**Protective Headwear Rules.**

Correct riding attire must be worn at all times. When mounted at any BRC event whether competing or not Protective Headwear must be worn & fastened under the chin is mandatory .

All hats must have the **aqua hat tag visible** with either BRC, PC or BE logos. Failure to do so will incur elimination.

All protective headwear can be checked at the Area 6 competitions and tagged before competing if you have not got the aqua tag.
