Flu Vaccinations and microchips

All horses Flu vaccinations will need to return to the 6 months & 21 days ruling as of 1st October 2020.

No flu injection should be done any later than 7 days before the competition date.

Please can you check that your horse's flu vaccinations are up to date before entering.

Since COVID-19 there are changes in the Area 6 Q competitions & how they are organised.

The new change is instead of you having to your horse's passport checked at the secretary's office on the competition day.

All passports are checked well before the day of the competition by the Team managers of your own riding club.

You will be asked to send a photo of your horse's passport with horse's name, passport number & microchip number.

Photos of the dates of vaccinations from the start of 1st, 2nd & 3rd dates up to the current & recent vaccination this year.

These will be recorded on an excel sheet for future reference and help to speed up checking for any Area qualifiers entered going forward.

Please carefully read the important eligibility rules for both horse and rider to compete in each class for Area 6 Summer Area Dressage qualifiers on 27th June 2021. **Special rules for Summer Dressage**: If we are unable to make up a team of 4 riders, but can make up a team of 3riders this is allowed in Class 1, 2 or 5.

Please come forward and join a team to represent the OBHRC.

Class 1: Senior Prelim Dressage Teams and individuals

Team of 4 riders to ride 1 xP2, 1x P12, 1x P14, 1X P18.

(All teams members are automatically entered as individuals in classes 1a, 1b, 1c, 1d) BD Prelim tests: 2, 12 & 14.

- * Horse eligibility: Unlimited Prelim points. 0 points at Novice or above.
- * Horses cannot have competed in Elementary dressage or above in the Same competition year BD or BRC.
- * Rider eligibility (not permitted): FBHS, BHSI, BHSII.
- * Rider cannot have competed at BE Novice or Elementary dressage or above in the current or previous calendar year BD or BRC.
- ** Senior Prelim BD Test 18:

Horse eligibility: Unlimited Prelim points. Up 35 points at Novice or above.

* Horses cannot have competed in Elementary dressage or above in the Same competition year BD or BRC.

Class 1a: Senior Prelim Dressage individuals Dressage Test: BD Prelim 2 (2016)

Class 1b: Senior Prelim Dressage individuals Dressage test: BD Prelim 12 (2005)

Unlimited Elementary points. Up to 35 Medium pts. No pts Adv Medium or above.

Horse and rider

- * Horse eligibility: Up to 35 Prelim points. No points Novice or above.
- * Horses cannot have competed in Novice or above in the current or previous competition year BD or BRC.
- * Rider eligibility (not permitted): FBHS, BHSI, BHSII.
- * Rider cannot have competed at BE Novice or Elementary dressage or above in the current or previous calendar year BD or BRC.

Class 4: Senior Pick-a-test Medium / Advanced Medium individuals

Tests: BD Medium 69 (2005) or BD Advanced Medium 91 (2016)

- * Horse eligibility for Medium 69: Unlimited Medium points. Up to 35 Advanced Medium points or above.
- * Horse eligibility for Adv Medium 91: Unlimited Advanced Medium points.

 Up to 50 points at Advanced or above

Class 5: Senior Riding Test Teams & individuals

Team of 4 riders to ride 2 x P 13, 2 x N27.

(all team members are automatically entered as individuals in classes 5a or 5b)

Class 5a: Senior Riding Test individuals - Prelim 13 (2016)

- * Horse eligibility Prelim: Unlimited Prelim points. Up to 35 Novice. No Elem pts Class 5b: **Senior Riding Test** individuals Novice 27 (2007)
- * Horse eligibility Novice: Unlimited Novice points. Up to 35 Elementary. No Med Pts

Class 12: London & South East Teams Qualifiers

4 riders (Junior & Seniors) each to ride BD Prelim 14 (2016)

Rider and horse eligibility rules for L&SE Q.

Test may be commanded & whips carried. Spurs are allowed.

Riders: Not gained pony Club A test or BHS Stage 4 Senior Coach in the last 10 years.

Rider not have gained FBHS or BHS Stage 5 Performance Coach.

Horses: must not have qualified for Senior Open National RC Championships in the last 2 yrs in Dressage.

Riders not have competed at Medium level or above in BD events in last 3 yrs.

Horse/ Rider combination not to have gained any BD points at Elementary or above in the last 2 years.

(Five teams can qualify for the dressage Championships in Sussex on 10th October).
