Training Clinics

Sadly we cancelled the January Jump clinic due to the Equine Herpes Virus. Sunday 23rd February was successful with 7 members booked in with Natasha Pirie Morrell at Chiltern Cottage Livery. Despite the wind & rain everyone had a good lesson, Natasha sets interesting & challenging jump courses. We are lucky that she & her horses are on the BS Young Horse training programme which gives riders the chance to train with top class coaches. Natasha passes on this knowledge to help members with their jumping skills.



March Clinic on Saturday morning 21st we are organising a slightly different training sessions: simulated arena XC training with Georgie Dalton – former event rider at her large arena, Cotton Springs Farm, Friendless Lane, Flamstead, AL3 8BJ. This lane is actually between the top of Markyate (Cheverells Green) – Flamstead. The cost is £25 each in a group of 2/3 riders. Area 6 Qualifying Competitions

Saturday 7th March is the Winter Show Jumping competition at BCA. SL6 6QR. We have a team of four in the 70cm, one individual in 80cm & two riders in the 90cm class.

Thank you very much to Ellie for offering to be the volunteer helper for half a day, this means all our riders can compete.

Sunday 12th April is the Combined training competition, this is open to teams and individuals. There are four classes with two x BE (prelim level tests) with SJ course at 75cm & two BE (Novice level tests) with SJ course at 85cm. For the team we need two riders competing in the two prelim level & two riders at Novice level. Individuals can chose with level they want enter.

There are two new extra classes: Riders can ride a BE Prelim level test & jump at 85cm or BE Novice level test & jump at 75cm.

Area 6 Horse Trials qualifier is on Sunday 24th May at Snowball Farm, Burnham Beeches.

Class levels for Area Q: 80cm, 80cm open, 90cm, 100cm, 100+. With the L&SE qualifier at 80cm.

New L&SE qualifier is a combined training competition with four riders in a team: Dressage test Prelim 7 & SJ course at 70cm. Restrictions: Horses unlimited BD points at Prelim & not to have won more than 35 BD pts at Novice. Rider / Horse combination not to have been placed in top 6 in BE 90 or completed a BE 100 or above in the last 3 years. **Volunteer helpers:** For any members to compete in these Area & L&SE competitions we have as club to provide at least one helper for half day. This is always the difficult part to find someone kind enough to give up their time to support other members. If you can offer your help at any of these dates our Team Managers would be very grateful.

Summer Evening Dressage Series

All dressage tests will be on a 20m x 40m fenced arena, with large 40m x 40m warming up arena. The car park is hard standing.

The classes include Intro, Prelim & Novice tests with restricted sections in Intro & Prelim classes.

For the third year running, OBHRC members will be entered into points league challenge in all classes & sections.

Championship & Reserve Champion rosettes are awarded at the AGM & Awards evening at the end of the year.
