XC Training Instruction at MKEC

Sunday 20th September with instructor & ex event rider Georgie Dalton. This is a good opportunity to for riders & their horses & ponies to experience riding in open spaces & brush up on XC riding & jumping skills. Also a very useful for those members wanting to compete at the Arena Eventing on 27th September.

MKEC has a brilliant well maintained grass XC course with a wide variety of fences including 2 water complexes, ditches, logs, drops, steps & all sorts of styles of rustic fences at different heights. Quite a lot of the jumps have take off & landing surfaces. Fence heights start from 60cm – 110cm.

There is also a mini / beginners XC course with fences from 30cm – 60cms in an enclosed field suitable for those riders & horses / ponies just starting out or wanting their first experience over XC fences. The mini XC lessons will be about 1 hour with small groups of 2 or 3 riders.

The main XC course sessions will be $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours with 3/4 riders in groups.

Prices including XC course hire & instruction: Mini course @ £40 per rider.

Main course depending on how many riders want book: up to 8 @ £50 per rider or 8 riders or more the price @ £45 per rider.

The PYO class Medium & Advanced Medium combined tests: Louise & Welly competed in the Advanced Medium finishing in 5th place. Scilla & her lovely grey horse Ash were placed equal 1st place in the medium & 6th place in Advanced medium test.

Autumn - Winter Area 6 Qualifiers

The popular Arena Eventing is going ahead on Sunday 27th September at Cherwell Competition Centre, Oxford. There are classes at 100cm, 90cm, 80cm & 70cm.

This competition comprises of a course of 8-9 show jumps, followed straight on over a twisty course of 10 solid XC style fences including trot / canter through water splash just off the side of the arena & finishing with a show Jump Joker fence. The whole course is judged on an optimum time with penalties gained either side of course time.

We are hoping to enter teams & individuals in most of the height levels.

The cost of entry is £41 per rider, which covers the Pre- entry, main entry fee & paramedic covers.

All entry payments close on Wednesday 2nd September. These need to be paid into the OBHRC bank account.
