- 1. The decision of the Organisers & Judges is final. They have the right to alter, amend or cancel any part of the competition, or refuse entries without stating a reason.
- 2. All horses or ponies must be 4 years old & over in ridden classes.
- 3. No horses or ponies will be allowed to be lunged near the rings
- 4. Correct riding attire including protective riding hats fastened under the chin, must be worn when mounted.
- **5**. Riders should wear hats in accordance with current requirements.
- **6.** In the interest of health & safety everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid & prevent accidents occurring & must obey the instructions of organisers & stewards on the day.
- **7.** Please do not leave horses / ponies tied up to your vehicles on their own.
- **8.** Please take all your litter home. Don't leave mess round trailers / lorries.
- 9. All dogs must stay in your vehicles or only in parking area kept on a lead.
- 10. Objections must be written and handed to the Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident, together with a deposit of £20. If the objection is sustained the £20 will be refunded.
- 11. Neither the Old Berkeley Hunt Riding Club (The Club) nor any members' of it's committee, nor any person acting on behalf of the club, or of the property shall be held responsible for any accident, damage, injury or loss to entrants by attending this show.
- 12. Entry to this show constitutes acceptance of the Rules & Conditions.

- Class 4: Mountain & Moorland. Pure bred of any age. Registered & unregistered.

 Large Breeds: New Forest, Fell, Dales, Highland, Connemara, Welsh C &D.
- **Class 5: Young Handlers** 18 yrs & under by 1st August in current year. Judged only of handler's ability to show H/P & neatness of handler.
- * **In- Hand Championships** for classes: 1, 2a & b, 3,4, 5 : **1**st **place** will qualify for Championships.
- Class 6: Coloured, odd Colours & Spots
 Skewbalds, piebald, palominos, duns, appaloosas, roans, spots, paints, creams.
- Class 7: Veteran Horses & ponies 15 years & over. Special rosette Best 21 yrs +
- Class 8: Foreign & Rare Breeds: Open to all breeds including Arabs.
- Class 9: Open Part Bred Open to horse or pony of any height & age.
- Class 10: Blemishes Don't Count: Open to all horses & ponies.

 Judged on manners & turnout. Any blemishes, scars etc .. not counted.

COVID Safe rules & restrictions for the showing show.

Please respect to following guidelines & rules below as we are trying to help everyone get their horses & ponies out to a show, while maintaing a very safe environment in which to compete.

- * Please do not come if you or a member of your family is feeling unwell or have COVID-19 symtoms
- * Please bring your own hand sanitsers & wash hands regularly.
- * Class sizes will be strictly limited a maximum of 8 competitors per class or section.
- * Each rider or handler will only be allowed one helper or family member.
- * No extra people will be allowed to enter the show ground.
- * All lorries & car- trailer vehicles registration plates will be checked at the gate entrance & directed to a marked parking space to allow for social distancing.
- * No groups of more than 6 people are allowed together anywhere on the show ground & social distancing must be adhered to at all times.
- * Only up to 6 riders / handlers with H/P are allowed in the warm up area at one time.
- * Competitors to use own bridle numbers or will need to make own printed numbers up.

- Class 11: Lead Rein Mare or gelding not to exceed 128cms. Riders not to attained their 8th birthday before 1st January 2020. Shown in snaffle bridle with lead rein attached to noseband only.
- Class 12: First Ridden Pony. Not exceeding 138cms. Riders not to have attained their 10^{th} birthday by 1^{st} January in current year. Shown in snaffle bridle only.
- Class 13: Show Pony / Show Hunter Pony SHP not exceed 153cm. Show Pony not exceed 148cm.
- **Class 14: Novice Ridden Horse & Pony.** Not to have been placed 1st in a showing class. Walk & trot only. Aimed at new combinations or new riders. No Stallions.
- Class 15: Coloured, Odd Colours & Spots.

 Skewbalds, Piebald, Palominos, Dun, Appaloosas, Roans, Spots, Paints, Creams.
- Class 16: Veteran Horses & ponies 15 years plus, Special rosette Best 21 yrs +
- * Ridden Championship for classes: 11 16: 1st place will qualify for Championships.

- Class 17: Mountain & Moorland. Pure bred of any age. Registered & unregistered.

 Small breeds: Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh section A & B.
- Class 18: Mountain & Moorland Pure bred any age. Registered & unregistered.

 Large breeds: New Forest, Fell, Dales, Highland, Connemara, Welsh C & D.
- **Class 19: Open Riding Horse** Open to horses exceeding 148cm
 To be judged on group ride, manners & individual show.
- Class 20: Open Hunter Exceeding 153 cm. Open to light, medium, heavy hunter type.
- Class 21: Open Part Bred Open to horses and ponies any height & age.

- Class 22: Pony Club / Riding Club horse & pony. Judged on manners & way of going.
