Arena UK, Grantham, up the A1 nearly 100 miles! Friday 25th – Sunday 27th April. Nine members competing in two teams and individual class championships with four support crew: Jillian Luff, Liz Rollinson, Kirsty Scott's mum Fiona & Diane.

The classes were big and the competition was strong from riders of other riding clubs all around the UK including from Scotland & Cornwall.

The championships started and finished very well for all our members with the **Novice team riders** competing on Friday: Paula Wynn, Tamsin Morris, Jane Bancroft, Alison Dippenaar (2nd in her arena over 70%) all rode good tests finishing in 16th position against 35 other RC teams.

Saturday saw our intermediate team compete with Jane Bancroft (2nd place) Janine Modder (8th place), Kirsty Scott (8th place) Charlotte Rollinson (14th position), Everyone rode brilliant tests and finished with overall Team 2nd place as BRC reserve intermediate **champions** – out of 33 other teams from all over the UK which was fantastic. Tamsin Morris also finished in 2nd place as individual in the elementary 1 & 3rd place in novice 3. Louise Riley-Hunt finished in 2nd place in the PYO - advanced medium test. We had three members competing in the dressage to music championships. Elizabeth Etchells rode a beautiful test on Maurice won the novice no BD on 71%

Louise Riley-Hunt & Welly rode a stunning advanced medium test with a very bold medium canter one handed – awarded 2nd place. Kirsty Scott & Charlie danced their socks off for 68.61% to finish 9th in the Novice + BD pts At the dressage championship 1st, 2nd & 3rd placed riders all received sashes, rosettes & goodie bags by the sponsors. Each class & teams received rosettes from 1st – 10th place. Thank you very much to Jane Bancroft who organises all the BRC area 6 dressage qualifiers and the championship entries.

Congratulations to everyone who jumped and represented the OBRC. There were personal best rounds for most of our members who jumped.

The new BRC "club jumping competition" started first in the outdoor arena. Carina Vials & Ted competed in the 50cm & 60cm classes, this was their very first proper jumping competition and they jumped a double clear at both height.

Our 60cm -65cm team jumped well over a tricky course and finished in 3rd place: Hannah Brookfield, Gina Elliott, Lynne Priest & Louise Pusey who finished 2nd individually. Elaine Browne jumped as individual and finished in 8th position with a DC. Our 70 – 75cm team all jumped brilliantly and finished in 1st place with Gina Elliott, Julie Fleming, Ellie Rose, and Louise Pusey. Ellie won the class and Louise came 3rd. Leah Upton jumped as an individual in the 80-85cm cm class and just had 4 faults.
