#### **New BRC Competition Pass**

The OBRC committee have agreed to pay for these passes to help club members with their total entry fees. The passes cost £30 per member for 12 months & will be allocated to any members who wants to compete in Area 6 qualifiers in 2026.

#### **\*\* If any member would like to buy their own competition pass to help the club**

**Volunteer helpers OBRC will need to provide one non competing helper per team or 4 individuals at this competition.**

If you are willing to spare half a day to be a volunteer helper for show duties, please contact Anka. Thank you in advance.

#### **Details of heights and eligibility rules for horses & riders in each class.**

The qualifiers consist of both teams & individuals for all height levels.

**All classes will run as single phase. The whole course is timed.**

**Extra rules:** Riders can enter more than one or two class as a team member or an individual.

60cm + 70cm / 70cm + 80cm / 80cm + 90cm / 90 + 100cm.

\*\* The 60cm class is the first class of the day – early start.

#### **Rider's eligibility for 60cm, 70cm, 80cm, 90cm classes.**

Riders not to have completed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years.

**Senior & Junior mixed 60cm:** first half: 60cm second half: 65cm

#### **Horse/ pony eligibility –**

Horses may not have completed a BS/BE 85cm or above or any discipline BRC championship at 90cm or above in the previous 12 months. (*That's before 11<sup>th</sup> February*). Horses may not have completed a BS 100cm or BE 2\* or above in the previous 2 years.

**Senior 70cm:** First half: 70cm second half: 75cm.

**Horses / ponies eligibility:** Horses may not have completed a BS/ BE at 95cm or above or any discipline BRC championship 100m or above in the previous 12 months before pre-entry. (*That's before 11<sup>th</sup> February*)

Horses may not have completed a BS 1m 10cm or BE 3\* or above in the previous 2 years.

**Senior 80cm Novice:** First half 80cm second half: 85cm.

**Horse / pony eligibility –** Horses may not have completed a BS/BE 105cm or above in the previous 12 months. (*That's before 11<sup>th</sup> February*)

Horses may not have completed a BS 1m 20cm or BE 4\* or above in the previous 2 years.

**Senior & Junior mixed 90cm: First section: 90cms second half: 95cms.**

Horses may not have completed a BS/BE 115cm or above in the previous 12 months (*That's before 11<sup>th</sup> February*)

**Senior & Junior mixed 100cm:** First half: 100cm second half: 1.05cm.

Horse / pony eligibility – No limits

All double clears share 1<sup>st</sup> place.

Class A: 40cm speed 250 mpm – Entry fee: £15

Class B: 50cm speed 250 mpm – Entry fee: £15

Class C: 60cm speed 250 mpm – Entry fee: £15

**Entries Close: Friday 20<sup>th</sup> February or sooner if classes are full**

**CLUB SHOWJUMPING – OPEN TO RIDING CLUB MEMBERS AND NON MEMBERS**

The course will be a simple with approximately 8/9 jumping efforts with minimal fillers

**NON RIDING CLUB MEMBERS** All riders may have assistance in the ring (1 person only). If not being led the assistant may move around the arena with the competitor but most not jump the fences.

Coaching & encouragement around the course is permitted.

If the judge feels that it is unsafe to carry on, they will ring the bell.

There will be a generous time allowed after which the judge will ring the bell and ask you to leave.

All clear rounds will share 1<sup>st</sup> place.

These classes have no eligibility restrictions on either horse or rider but in the spirit of the competition should not be entered by combinations capable of competing at 70cm or higher.

**RIDING CLUB MEMBERS WISHING TO QUALIFY – CHAMPIONSHIP AT BURY FARM in Sept 2026**

those wishing to qualify must join an affiliated Riding Club and acquire the 2 clear rounds in order to participate at the championships.

Those wishing to qualify must be clear at chosen heights in 2 shows within the qualifying period.

**OPEN JUMPING CLASSES – SINGLE PHASE**

**All combinations not eliminated in the first part of the course will continue into the timed section. Fastest double clear wins**

Class 101: 60cm single phase competition 300 mpm Entry fee: £22

Class 102: 70cm single phase competition 300 mpm Entry fee: £22

Class 103: 80cm single phase competition 325 mpm Entry fee: £22

Class 104: 90cm single phase competition 325 mpm Entry fee: £22

Class 105: 100cm single phase competition 325 mpm Entry fee: £22

**PARAMEDIC FEE OF £5 WILL BE ADDED FOR EACH RIDER.**

We will endeavour to ensure that competitors times are close together as possible but [lease be aware that if you are travelling with another competitor doing separate classes then there may be a longer wait. These classes will be run concurrently with BRC Qualifier classes.

**Please note – these classes are not open to BRC combinations entered into the Area 6 qualifying classes except where they have already completed their BRC classes.**
