New BRC Competition Pass: Starts from 1st September 2025.

The OBRC committee have agreed to pay for these passes to support club members with their total entry fees. The passes cost £30 per member for 12 months & will be allocated to members once they have paid their first set of entry fees to compete in Area 6 qualifiers for winter season 2025 or during 2026.

Timings for test classes please be aware that the morning classes can start as early as 8.30am and afternoon classes can go on until 4.00pm. * Please be prepared for an early start from home. *Times may vary and if riding two test classes so do allow for waiting times between. ** If you are travelling with another club member please notify Jane Bancroft as she can make note on the entry form.

Details of tests with eligibilities for teams & individuals.

Please carefully read the important eligibility rules for both horse and rider to compete in this Area 6 winter grassroots qualifier.

The British Riding Club (BRC) prelim A and B test sheets will be available to download from the club website: www.obrc.org.uk – Competition page.

Riders competing in team tests will automatically entered as individuals in that class. Rider & horse/ pony combinations can also enter another class as an individual.

Senior grassroots teams of 4 riders: *1 x BD intro 1 (2024)

*1 x BD intro 2 (2024) * 1 x BRC prelim 1 (2025) * 1 x BRC prelim 2 (2025)

The two intro tests are British Dressage 2024 tests

Senior grassroots Intro tests: BD intro 1 (2024) and BD intro 2 (2024)

* **Horse eligibility:** 0 BD points at any level.

* Horses cannot have competed in Novice dressage BD, BRC or BE 100 or above in the 12 months before close of entry. Not to have competed Elementary BD, BRC or BE novice in the last 3 calendar years.

* **Rider eligibility** (not permitted): BHS Stage 4 Coach or above (formally BHSI)

* Rider cannot have competed at Novice dressage BD, BRC or BE 100 or above in the 12 months before the close of pre-entry.

* Not competed Elementary BD, BRC or BE novice in the last 3 calendar years.

* **Horse & Rider Combinations** not to have gained 70% or higher in their arena at a BRC/ BD championship at intro level or above.

Senior grassroots Prelim tests:

BRC Prelim A test (2025) and BRC Prelim B test (2025)

* **Horse eligibility:** Up to 35 BD Prelim points. 0 points at BD Novice or above.

* **Horses:** cannot have competed in elementary BD/ BRC or BE Novice or above in the 12 months before the close of entry.

* **Rider eligibility** (not permitted): BHS Stage 4 Coach or above (formally BHSI).

* Rider cannot have competed at Elementary BD / BRC or BE novice or above in the current or previous calendar year.

* **Horse & Rider Combinations** not to have gained 70% or higher in their arena at a BRC/ BD championship at prelim level or above in the last 12 months.

Wellington Riding has a large parking area. Good facilities including café.
