Timings for test classes: Please be aware that the morning classes can start as early as 8.30am and afternoon classes can go on until 4.00pm. *Times may vary and if riding two test classes do allow for waiting times between. ** If you are travelling with another club member please notify Jane Bancroft as she can make note on the entry form.

Wellington Riding is just off the M4 – south of Reading.

Good facilities: very large outdoor arena for the dressage arenas plus warm arenas.

Good sized indoor school sometimes used for a few tests. Large parking area & café.

Details of tests with eligibilities for teams of four riders & individuals.

Please carefully read the important eligibility rules for both horse and rider to compete.

Teams: 1x BD Intro 3 (2024) 1x BD Prelim 1 (2024) 1x Prelim 2 (2024)

1 x BD Novice 1 (2024) All riders competing in a team are automatically entered in that test as an individual as well. Riders are welcome to enter two tests.

BD Intro 3 (2024)

Horse eligibility: Up to 35 Prelim Points. 0 points at BD Novice or above.

Rider eligibility (not permitted): BHS Stage 4 Coach or above (formally BHSI)

BD Prelim 1 (2024)

Horse eligibility: Unlimited prelim points. *Up to 35 points at Novice. 0 BD points at Elementary or above. *Not to have competed at Elementary BD/BRC or BE Novice or above in the current or previous calendar year.

Rider eligibility: Not to be a BHS Stage 4 Coach or above

Not to have competed at Elementary BD/ BRC or BE Novice or above in the Current or previous calendar year.

BD Prelim 2 (2024)

Horse eligibility: Unlimited prelim points.

Up to 35 points at Novice. 0 BD points at Elementary or above. *Not to have competed at Elementary BD/BRC or BE Novice or above in the current or previous year.

Rider eligibility: Not to be a BHS Stage 4 Coach or above

Not to have competed at Elementary BD/ BRC or BE Novice or above in the Current or previous year.

BD Novice 1 (2024)

Horse eligibility: Unlimited Novice points

Up to 35 points at Elementary. 0 BD points at Medium or above

Rider eligibility: Not to be a BHS Stage 4 Coach or above

Not to have competed at Medium BD/BRC or BE intermediate or above in the current or previous year.

BRC Intro Pairs (BRC Intro test 2022)

Horse eligibility: Unlimited Prelim points. 0 points at novice or above.

Rider & horse eligibility: Not to have competed at Novice BD / BRC (including pairs) or BE100 or above in current or previous year. **Rider:** Not to be a BHS stage 4 coach or above. Winning pair from previous year may not take part.
