Eleven members travelled to Wellington equestrian, just south of Reading to compete and represent OBRC in the grassroots and open dressage qualifiers on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> October. Everyone had a brilliant outing competing against riders from ten other riding clubs in Area 6.

Our **Grassroots team** finished in 3<sup>rd</sup> place with all three members being placed individually: Louise Bennett (6th intro test), Ellie Rose (3<sup>rd</sup> prelim test) and Julie Fleming (1<sup>st</sup> prelim test). Julie also won her individual prelim test with 75%.

We were able to put together two open dressage teams: **Blue team** finished in 1<sup>st</sup> place: Carol Fletcher (2<sup>nd</sup> prelim), Jane Bancroft (1st novice), Alison Dippenaar (8<sup>th</sup> novice), Tamsin Morris (2nd elementary).

**Gold team** finished in 5<sup>th</sup> place with Alex Iona-Smith (4<sup>th</sup> prelim), Janine Modder (16<sup>th</sup> novice), Kirsty Scott (1<sup>st</sup> elementary). PYO medium test: Tamsin Morris (4<sup>th</sup>) and Jillie Luff (5<sup>th</sup>).

### **Upcoming Area 6 Competitions**

Winter intermediate dressage competition qualifiers are coming up on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> December at Wellington Equestrian. We have two teams and some individual tests entered. The teams are made up of one intro test, two prelim tests and one novice test.

**Dressage to music** competition qualifiers are on Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> January at Berkshire College, just south of High Wycombe. All tests are ridden indoors with warm up outside. Classes to qualify for the dressage championships at Arena UK in April are prelim, novice no BD points and novice with BD points, elementary, medium, advanced medium, open pairs.

Qualifiers for London & South East DTM championships are intro, novice test in fancy dress and pairs in fancy dress. Schedule with all the classes and eligibility rules is on the AREA 6 page of website: <a href="www.obrc.org.uk">www.obrc.org.uk</a> Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> February – winter show Jumping competition qualifiers at Berkshire College, south of High Wycombe - open to RC teams and individuals. Classes from 60cm – 100cm.

The new BRC Club jumping classes will also be in this schedule.

For riders and horses or ponies only wanting to jump at 40cm, 50cm, 60cm. Schedule will be on the website in January.
