Details of all the different classes

Please read the schedule carefully and check the eligibility rules. For the BRC DTM qualifiers the winner of each class qualifies for championships. Extra riders are invited depending on the number of entries in the class.

* Prelim Dressage to Music - Test: BD Prelim Freestyle to Music (2016)

Horse eligibility: Unlimited BD Prelim points. * No BD points at Novice or above.

Cannot have competed in elementary or above in same competition year BD or BRC.

No horse may have gained 70% or above in DTM novice (BD or BRC) in the past 12 months.

Rider eligibility: Not to have the BHS Stage 4 coach or above qualification within the past 10 yrs. (Formally BHSI and above)

Riders cannot have competed at BE Novice or Elementary dressage or above in the current year or previous calendar year BD or BRC.

- * Novice Dressage to Music (0 BD pts) Test: BD Novice Freestyle to Music (2019) (Horses downgraded by BRC to zero points are eligible).

 Horse eligibility: Unlimited BD Prelim points. ** No points at Novice or above.

 Horses cannot have competed in elementary or above in same competition year BD / BRC. Horse may not compete in Elementary DTM at same qualifier or championship.

 Rider's eligibility: Riders cannot have competed at BE Novice or Elementary dressage or above in the current or previous calendar year BD or BRC.
- * Novice Dressage to Music (+ BD pts) Test: BD Novice Freestyle to Music 2019 Horse eligibility: Unlimited Novice pts. Up to 35 Elementary pts. No Medium or above.
- * Elementary Dressage to Music Test: BD Elementary Freestyle to Music (2019) Horse eligibility: Unlimited Elementary pts. Up to 35 Medium pts. No pts at Advanced Meduim or above.
- * Medium /Advanced Medium Dressage to Music
 Test: PYO BD Medium & Advanced Medium Freestyle to Music (2016)
 Horse eligibility: Medium & advanced medium: No limits for horses or ride
- * Open Novice Mixed Pairs Test: BRC Novice Pairs Dressage to Music Freestyle (2018) No restrictions for horses or riders

Class: Intro Dressage to music

Test –BD intro Freestyle to Music (2016)

Please note intro test will be ridden in a 20m x 40m arena for intro only.

Rider eligibility: must not have gained BHSI or higher BHS qualification. **Restrictions**: Not open to those competing in BD Novice classes or above.

Class: Pas Seul (Dressage to music in costume)

Test: L&SE Novice Championship DTM in Costume – Pas Seul 2013 In addition to the marks for technical performance, additional marks for the artistic section including the costume.

Class: **Pas De Deux** (Pairs dressage to music in costume) Test: L&SE Novice DTM in Costume – Pas Seul 2013

Protective Headwear Rules and pink hat tags

Body protectors if worn

Flu vaccinations

Really important that horse's flu vaccinations are up to date in order to compete at BRC area competitions and championships.

The passports are being checked at the competitions at the secretary's office before riders compete.

BRC AREA 6 DRESSAGE TO MUSIC – licensing rules

BRC members **do not** need to join the British Dressage (BD) to compete in the BRC DTM competition qualifiers as it falls under the BRC licence now.

Riders only need to be a BD member if competing in BD music classes.

The new rule for using different types of music only applies the to BRC music classes. Members can use any music from the record label on Phonographic Performance Ltd (PPL). Music not on the list can still be use but not along side the PPL listed music
