**New BRC Competition Pass:** Starts on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2025.

The OBRC committee have agreed to pay for these passes to help club members with their total entry fees. The passes cost £30 per member for 12 months & will be allocated to any member who have paid their entry fee to compete in Area 6 qualifiers in 2025 – 2026.\* If you'd like to purchase your own, please let Jane know before closing date.

**Mixed senior & Junior Dressage Teams of 4 riders** 1 x BD Prelim 3 ( 2024) 1 x BD Novice 2 (2024) 1 x BD Novice 3 (2024) 1 x BD Elementary 1 (2024)

\* **BD Prelim 3 ( 2024)** (Mixed seniors & Juniors )

**Horse eligibility:** Unlimited Prelim points. Up to 35 novice points.

No points at elementary or above

\* **BD Novice 2 (2024)** (Mixed seniors & Juniors )

**Horse eligibility:** Unlimited novice points. \*Up to 35 BD points at any higher level.

\* **BD Novice 3 (2024)** (Mixed seniors & Juniors )

**Horse eligibility:** Unlimited novice points.\* Up to 35 BD points at any higher level.

\* **BD Elementary 1 (2024)** (Mixed seniors & Juniors )

**Horse eligibility:** Unlimited BD Elementary points. Up to 35 BD pts at any higher level.

\* **PICK A TEST– BD medium 2 (2024) or BD Advanced Medium 1 ( 2024)**

**Horse eligibility:** No limits (Mixed seniors & Juniors

**Timings for test classes**

Please be aware that the morning classes can start as early as 8.30am and afternoon classes can go on until 4.00pm. \* Unfortunately sometimes one of the novice test's could be a morning test, so be prepared for at early start from home.
