
Right now, members are soliciting area business for donations to our live auction as well as for the basket raffles. The invitations have been printed, and the mailings will be prepared at the August meeting.

CALL TO ORDER: The June meeting of the Mesquite Club Executive Board was called to order by President Barbara Bolling at 10 a.m.

CORRESPONDING SECRETARY:

COMMUNITY SERVICES: Veteran's Village was selected as the charity for the 2018-2019 year. They provide housing and assistance for our veterans. Sue, Kay and Art McClure met with Arnold Stalk at the facility for a tour and to find out how the club can help with other things. The committee would like to help by in-kind donations, as well.
