WHAT'S GOING ON


DORIS FRENCH SCHOOL: Please bring school supplies to fill our *Little Red Wagon*. With the school year starting, supplies will be needed.

MARCH RUMMAGE SALE: It's NEVER too late to bring in items for our March Rummage Sale to put in our club storage units. Furniture is especially appreciated.







- June Eckenroth read resignation letters from: Joan O'Connor Braun & Betty Ault. Phyllis Hendrickson moved to accept with regret Nancy Zangl seconded motion carried.
- Nancy Zangl distributed a report which included the following information; 1 new member in May, Total Membership 170 (109 Day, 50 Evening, 8 Sustaining, 3 Honorary). Dues collected for 2013/2014 \$9950 (\$6700 Regular, \$3000 Evening, \$250 Sustaining) there are approximately 50 members that have not paid.
