



BOARD BRIEFS

\$ MESQUITE CLUB FINANCIAL STATEMENT \$



The meeting of the Mesquite Club Executive Board was called to order by President Ilene Baker at 10:02 am.

Corresponding Secretary: Henri Hale—Joan Lemere has resigned her membership. A motion was made to accept Joan's resignation with regret. Motion Passed

Building Committee: Cathi Poer—A piece of PVC pipe located at the front of the building was accidentally broken and repaired. The following monies have been collected towards the Wrought Iron gates - \$3000 from Memorial Fund, \$2000 from crafts, \$1000 donation from a member. In order to complete the projects including the wrought iron on the wall we are approx. \$4,500 short. Ideas on how to raise the monies were discussed such as a game night, luncheon, gofundme.com, press release to Dawn Gibbons asking the community for donations. After much discussion a motion was made to fund the wrought iron project from the saving account not to exceed \$6000 and that we will plan fundraisers to repay the savings account. This motion is contingent on evening's approval of the bid. Motion Carried.

Landscaping Report: Linda Baxter spoke on the Landscaping issues. Pruning, planting of the grounds and attempts to save the Mesquite Tree are in process. The Ocotillo have died it is believed that it has grubs. There will be a \$50 fee to check for grubs and \$300 to replace the Ocotillo. Three patio trees have died. The cost to replace those would be \$150 each. It was discussed to replace one of the patio trees with a nice rose bush. A motion was made to spend no more than \$500 to test for grubs, treat for grubs if necessary, test the soil where the patio trees were planted and treat the soil if necessary. Motion Passed.

Christmas Luncheon: Cathi Poer requested \$1000 for a deposit towards the Christmas Luncheon. A motion was made to pay the deposit and to schedule the luncheon for December 11. Motion Passed

Other Business: Joan Lapan discussed the donation of books for Memorial. A representative from the Clark County Public Library will be asked to come speak on book donations. We will need to create our own book plates as the library no longer provides these.

May 16 is Helldorado Parade. We need a chairman and committee.

Meeting adjourned at 11:47am.
