Care Instructions

Our stocks use Birchwood Casey ® Tru-Oil ® finish. Tru-Oil is a durable and very forgiving finish which can easily be touched up and repaired (unlike polyurethane and epoxy-based finishes). For general maintenance, we recommend applying a furniture grade past wax (ie Minwax or Johnson) during routine gun cleaning. Apply wax liberally in a circular pattern, allow to dry, then remove/ buff with a cotton cloth. To remove light scratches and blemishes, lightly rub the area with #0000 steel wool in the direction of the grain, then apply paste wax as described above.

Woodshop Wednesday Custom Woodworking

STEP 1:

WARNING: PRIOR TO INSTALLING ANY PARTS ON YOUR FIREARM, ENSURE THAT YOUR RIFLE IS CLEARED AND THAT THE TRIGGER SAFETY IS

ENGAGED. INSTALL A CHAMBER FLAG TO ENSURE THAT THE CHAMBER IS

EMPTY. Separate the barrel from the receiver. With the barrel removed from your Ruger® PC Carbine™, remove the factory handguard by

unscrewing the mounting screw under the handguard. Below are the parts

required to assembly the barrel band.





STEP 2:

Install your new handguard using the original factory ruger mounting screw. Temporarily install the barrel onto the rifle with the woodstock installed and adjust the handguard position to be centered with the rifle stock. Once satisfied with the position, tighten the mounting screw to 10-12 in-lbs.

CAUTION: DO NOT TIGHTEN THE SCREWS TO FACTORY TORQUE; DAMAGE MAY OCCUR.





STEP 7:

Install swivel sling mount by holding in the button while inserting it into the desired hole. The sling mount can be installed on either side. The installation is now complete. Use this guide in reverse to remove the barrel band if needed.








STEP 6:

Reinstall both screws into the barrel band and tighten both until the lower gap is parallel. Do not overtighten these screws.



STEP 3:

Remove both screws from the barrel band using the 3mm Allen wrench provided. Thread one of the screws into the opposite side for the barrel band. Insert the zip tie provided into the gap and tighten the screw until it contacts the zip tie. Make sure the zip tie does not pass through the gap.







STEP 4:

Slowly turn the screw to spread the barrel clamp open enough to slide over the front sight guides on the barrel. Orient the barrel band as shown while installing.

STEP 5:

Once the band is over the front sight, slide the barrel band onto the handguard. Make sure the handguard is fully seated on the barrel and the barrel band is flush with the step on the handguard. Once in place, remove the screw and zip-tie.
