The floating mats are likely just more of a nuisance than anything. Overtime (slowly), the ones that are truly floating, will begin to break up and sink - but again it's no quick process. But there's not really a concern of them causing any algae issues, etc. as it's just organic material that was essentially already in the pond to begin with (and hopefully it will breakdown more quickly in its current format).
