ORDER GRANTING DEFAULT JUDGMENT

- 1. The Prosecution filed Case 8262024AOXA with the Court and served Defendant Amisi Ola Xi Amaru with the Case and Offer of Plea Agreement on August 26th, 2024.
- 2. Defendant rejected the Plea Offer and demanded a trial on August 28th, 2024.
- 3. However, Defendant never responded to the causes of action filed against her by Plaintiff, even after receiving several notices and an Order to do so.
- 4. Defendant appears to have gone silent concerning the matters in this case, having also failed to respond to the Temporary Restraining Order filed against her and the related Order to Show Cause.
- 5. Plaintiff filed a Motion for Default Judgment on September 17th, 2024 with an updated Remedy Demand.
- IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment is Granted. Defendant is found guilty of all charges of moral code violations (Moral Codes 6, 17, 18, 27).

The punitive and restorative actions ordered are as follows:

- 7. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant must privately apologize to for sharing messages with and provide proof to the ARNA NJS and the Plaintiff that received the message.
- 8. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant must complete 30 hours of community service for DOS as designated by DOS head facilitator officials (not including
- 9. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant must make a video with the following apology to the sisterhood of ARNA (DOS): "I Amisi Ola Xi Amaru violated the moral code of my government. I apologize to the sisterhood of ARNA for my actions and I

respect the decisions of the ARNA National Jural Society concerning this matter. I Apologize to Ali for carrying out an act that added division between who were under his care." This video must be delivered to the ARNA NJS and Chief Executive and will be posted in the ARNA Facebook group and DOS group.

- **10. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Defendant will serve a three (3) month probationary period where she will not engage any of the above referenced moral code violations amongst the women of ARNA, ending at 11:59pm EST on December 19th, 2024.
- 11. Defendant has the right to appeal this default judgment within thirty (30) days of the judgment date (the deadline to appeal being October 20th, 2024).
