ORDER

in re Defendant's Motion to Recuse

- 1. Defendant filed a Motion to Recuse against the NJS on September 18th, 2024.
- 2. Defendant stated in his motion that "The Majority of the NJS are biased in this case besides one member. I understand that there may be some concern from one or two members which may drive them to want to be involved but it is not a fair and impartial position to take. Furthermore, the jurist currently presiding over the NJS is biased because he resigned from the NJS as a result of my decision to not support his case of similar accusations. His words prior to announcing his resignation was that both I and the then Defendant were members of the Nation of Islam and I would back the then Defendant based on that affiliation alone. After clearing that accusation up in the presence of the NJS, said officer resigned from his position on the NJS."
- **3.** The Court ordered Defendant to submit a memorandum detailing which NJS Members he wanted to be recused from the case by September 27th, 2024.
- **4.** Defendant did not submit a memorandum or brief in support of his motion.
- 5. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant's Motion to Recuse is denied.
- **6.** Defendant did specify his claims for the recusal of NJS President Minister B'ak Amaru.
- 7. Based on the grounds Defendant has offered, Minister B'ak Amaru will not be recusing himself from this case.
