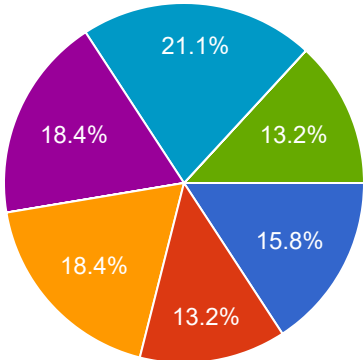

Date: April 25, 2026 (15,112 Aboriginal Calendar)

Session: Spring Legislative Session

Style: Referendum for Direct Vote of Aboriginal Nationals

**SECTION I – SHORT TITLE**

This Act shall be known as:

**The Government Restructuring Act (GRA)**

**SECTION II – PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Act is to:

- \* Permanently dissolve the Ministerial Congress as currently constituted under Unit 4 of the Constitution
- \* Establish the Rites of Passage Congress (ROP Congress) as the new legislative body
- \* Transfer all legislative powers of the Ministerial Congress to the ROP Congress



\* Amend/Redraft the ARNA Constitution to reflect the replacement of Ministerial Congress with ROP Congress in all clauses that apply. This will be done by the Chief Executive, reviewed by the ARNA NJS then published as the New ARNA Constitution.

\* Restrict legislative authority to qualified SOS & DOS officials

\* Reorganize governance around family-based representation and community structure

\* Promote interdependent family governance as a foundational unit of lawmaking

### **SECTION III – DISSOLUTION OF MINISTERIAL CONGRESS**

Amendment to Unit 4 – Organization of Parliament

The current provision stating:

*“Parliament shall be made up of two Houses, the Ministerial Congress and the Jural Society”*

is hereby amended to read:

*“Parliament shall be made up of two Houses: the Rites of Passage Congress (ROP Congress) and the Jural Society.”*

### **SECTION IV – ESTABLISHMENT OF ROP CONGRESS**

A new legislative body is created:

The Rites of Passage Congress (ROP Congress)

Structure:

Composed exclusively of SOS (Sons of the Shrine) and DOS (Daughters of the Shrine) officials

Officials must be:



- certified through Rites of Passage
- recognized Nationals in good standing

## **SECTION V – POWERS OF THE ROP CONGRESS**

The ROP Congress shall assume all powers previously held by the Ministerial Congress under:

Unit 5 – Powers of Parliament

Unit 6 – Exercise of Legislative Power

Including but not limited to:

- creation and amendment of laws
- economic and social legislation
- governance oversight
- national policy direction

## **SECTION VI – QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE**

To serve in the ROP Congress, an official must:

- Be a certified SOS or DOS official
- Be a recognized Aboriginal National in good standing

Have completed:

- Rites of Passage training
- Nationality exam
- Constitutional oath

(Aligned with Amendment 3 requiring Rites of Passage completion )



## **SECTION VII – FAMILY-BASED LEGISLATIVE PRINCIPLE**

Legislative authority shall be structured around:

- family units
- community interdependence
- collective responsibility

Provision:

Only Nationals operating within recognized family or community structures may:

- propose legislation
- participate in legislative voting

## **SECTION VIII – CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT AUTHORITY**

This Act is passed pursuant to:

Article 88–90 (Constitutional Revision)

and must be:

Submitted to referendum vote of the Nationals

## **SECTION IX – LEGAL TRANSITION**

Upon ratification:

- Ministerial Congress is immediately dissolved
- All pending legislative matters transfer to ROP Congress
- All references in the Constitution to:

*“Ministerial Congress”*



are replaced with:

*"Rites of Passage Congress"*

## **SECTION X – CONTINUITY OF GOVERNMENT**

All other branches remain intact:

- Jural Society (Judiciary)
- Chief Executive & Cabinet

as defined in the Constitution

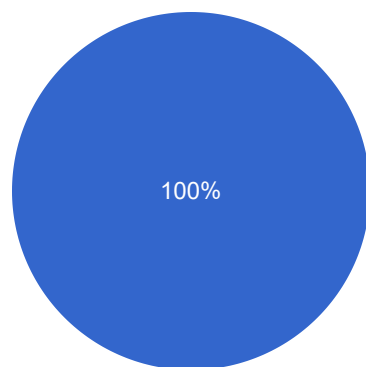
## **SECTION XI – ENACTMENT**

This Act shall take effect:

Immediately upon approval by referendum of the Aboriginal Nationals

Sponsor of this Bill: Chief Amaru Xi-Ali in his personal capacity as a National

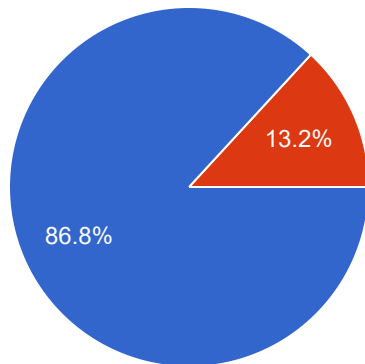


BALLOT QUESTION:

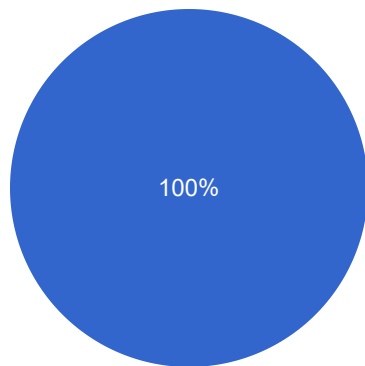
- YES — I APPROVE THIS ACT (I approve the restructuring of government and adoption of the Rites of Passage Congress as the legislative authority)
