This show continues to grow in quality and statewide participation. Judging focuses not only on the exhibitors' craftsmanship, but also on their ability to develop, design and document their project as well as successfully interact with a judges' panel. We invite you to come witness the talents of the youth of Texas!

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WHAT IS A JUNIOR AGRICULTURAL MECHANICS PROJECT?

Texas 4-H and FFA members team up (up to six team members per project) at the local level to design and construct a project to exhibit at the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo. This proves to be a showcase for their outstanding leadership, teamwork and technical abilities. Below is an overview of the variety of projects that are offered.

Ag Machinery & Equipment
