PROGRAM GOALS

The To'utupu 'Oe 'Otu Felenite Association (TOFA) supports and advances the awareness of Pacific Islander issues through education and outreach. The Education Scholarships will be awarded based on the availability of funds to students who will be attending college during the 2019-2020 academic year.

TOFA does not discriminate on the basis of race, gender, sexual orientation, religion, national and ethnic origin or disability. In support of TOFA's mission and goals, TOFA encourages application from students who have Pacific Islander ancestry.

Applicant Eligibility

All student applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a resident of Sacramento
- Be currently enrolled as an undergraduate or graduate student at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university.
- Must possess a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.75
- Must be able to produce two letters of recommendation to accompany application from two separate individuals not related to the applicant
- Must demonstrate commitment to the Pacific Islander community in a written personal statement.

Selection of Scholarship Recipients

TOFA Scholarship Selection Committee will make awards based on recipients having demonstrated commitment to the Pacific Islander community, abilities, academic achievements, career goals, civic activities, and leadership skills. All applicants will be notified by mail of the status of their application by **August 30, 2019**, regardless of outcome.

- I understand that late or incomplete applications will not be considered. My ability to accurately follow instructions will be considered during the selection process.
- I understand that if I'm not able to attend, I will send someone to represent me on **September 13, 2019**. If recipient or representative cannot attend, they may forfeit the scholarship.
- I certify that I am currently enrolled as an undergraduate or graduate college student at an accredited community college, college, or university.
- I hereby authorize TOFA to use information on my application and any photos that I provide for publicity or public relations purposes.
- I certify that all of my information on this application is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and that I will forfeit my award if any information that I provide is found to be deliberately false, inaccurate, or misleading.
