Dog Adoption Application

#### Please read all information below before proceeding!

We charge a non-refundable deposit of \$25 towards the adoption fee. This deposit is subtracted from the adoption fee upon adoption approval.

- You must be at least 21 years of age to adopt.
- We do not accept applications for dogs that are not promoted as being currently available.
- Please be prepared to show a copy of your deed or lease to our volunteers.
- Once approved, your application is good for 6 months.
- All animals in the home must be current on DHPP/Rabies vaccine, as well as spayed or neutered.
- We require background checks for all applicants, as well as those living in the home. By completing an application, you are agreeing to a background check.
- We may deny an application not meeting the aforementioned requirements or if we feel the home may not be a good fit.
- Once a volunteer receives your application, they will reach out via email. Applications who do
  not respond to the rescue administration / adopters in a 48-hour time frame, will have their
  application discarded.
- Applicants who are a no show for their meet and greet, or cancel last minute, may be subjected to their application being removed.
- After you application is approved, you will be notified via phone call. Dogs residing in the home will need to meet the dog be adopted.
- Please keep in mind that applications can take up to 1 week to process, due to the volume of
  applicants, reference checks and ensuring that we process applications thoroughly. If it has
  been more than 2 weeks, please email us at <a href="mailto:ataleofpaws@gmail.com">ataleofpaws@gmail.com</a>. Applicants who do not
  meet specific criteria for a dog that is detailed in their listing will not have their application
  processed.
- Please keep in mind that a dog and or cat is an approximate commitment of 1- 17-year commitment. Most of the animals in our program come from places of abuse, neglect and other mistreatment. They require understanding, time, patience and many of them, training. Please do not apply if you do not feel you are capable of giving a dog or cat at least 6 weeks to acclimate to their new environment.
- Typically, we do get more than one application per listed animal. We make placement decisions
  based on the best interest of the animal. Having an approved application does not guarantee
  you any specific animal.
- When applying, please give your vet permission to speak to us to help expedite the application process.
