What Is the Ride-Along Program?

This program allows approved participants to accompany a Morris Plains Police Officer during a regular patrol shift. It's a unique opportunity to observe police operations, ask questions, and gain insight into the challenges and responsibilities of modern policing.

Who Can Participate?

To ensure safety and professionalism, participants must meet the following criteria:

- Be at least 18 years old, or 16 years old with an accompanying parent/guardian
- Submit a completed Ride-Along Application and Waiver
- Pass a basic background check
- Receive approval from the Chief of Police

What to Expect

Ride-alongs typically last up to four hours and are scheduled based on availability. Participants will:

- Ride in a marked patrol vehicle
- Observe calls for service, traffic stops, and community interactions
- Learn about department procedures and public safety efforts
