The weather is getting warmer and the trails are becoming more active. The Montour Trail is for walkers, runners, bicyclists and other non-motorized recreation.

It's the country's longest suburban rail-trail, with the main line running 47 miles; a half-loop stretching from Coraopolis along the Ohio River to Clairton on the Monongahela. A northwest branch connects directly to Pittsburgh International Airport. Be sure to make use of this wonderful local resource for fun and fitness.

On Saturday, April 26, at 10 a.m., there will be a Blessing of the Bikes. All are invited to Mile 0 outside of Coraopolis on Route 51 (near the Highmark soccer fields) for a blessing of bicycles and their owners. Afterward, cyclists can proceed directly onto the trail for a ride. In the event of rain, an alternate date will be May 3.

The date has been set for the 2025 "Tour the Montour" event! This non-competitive family event is a fun bike ride that will take place Saturday, Sept. 20. The ride begins at Mile 0 in Coraopolis. Participants can park at AHN Montour Junction Sports Complex, adjacent to the start/finish line. The event features a variety of distances for every level of rider.
