

Application Guidelines

We are excited about your interest in the Redefining Dyslexia Scholarship. All dyslexic Callisburg High School senior students are eligible to apply for this scholarship upon meeting criteria. The following is a list of guidelines to help you through the application process.

Applicant Qualifications:

- I. Be enrolled in Callisburg High School as a Senior graduating in the Spring of 2025.
- 2. Plan to enroll in an institution of higher learning, university, or trade school.
- 3. Be in good standing with Callisburg ISD.
- 4. Have a documented diagnosis of Dyslexia.
- 5. Submit completed application, essay, and letter of recommendation by April 25th.

Essay

Your submitted essay can be handwritten, typed or even sent as Google slides or a video. Be creative and submit your story in a way that suits you- there is no right or wrong way to do this! There are no word count requirements and spelling errors will not be frowned upon. We understand that along with the talents and gifts dyslexia brings, it can also make things like spelling and writing difficult. We aren't looking for a perfectly written paper. What we are looking for, is your story, your journey. What teachers inspired you, what has been your biggest hurdle, when was your turning point? We want to know how your dyslexia has molded you into the person you are today and how you plan to use your strengths to be a world changer!

Letter of Recommendation

Your submitted letter of recommendation should be from a teacher or coach who has made an impact on your dyslexic journey. It can be a current teacher or a teacher from years past!
