WHERE: based in Brownsville, Texas, but serves families all over the world

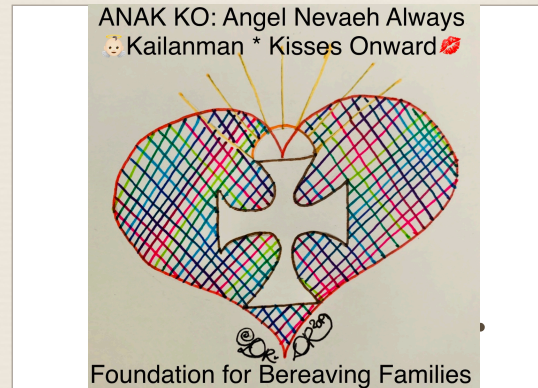
WHEN: established in 2020 during the pandemic
