MORNING LEAGUE

Play 18 holes.

Weekly sign up will be administered by the pro shop. You will receive an email to sign-up. Register by Tuesday at NOON. After 12:00, contact the pro shop directly if you need to cancel.

April – May: Announcements at 8:50, at your tee box at 9:00.

June – Sept: Announcements at 8:20, at your tee box at 8:30.

All putts must be holed.

Guest days: June 24th. We are allowing multiple guests this year. Format and hard signup date TBA.

For inclement weather, UNLESS the Pro Shop cancels, payouts will be made if at least two players show up and play at least 9 holes. For team events, at least two teams must play 9 holes. If play is cancelled, the payouts from that day will be set aside and

distributed as payouts at some point during the rest of the season as determined by the committee.

Payouts are distributed weekly. The weekly amounts are budgeted based on the previous year's enrollment. Once the current year's enrollment is confirmed, the amount may fluctuate depending on the actual number of AM BWGA members.

Unless otherwise specified, the Pro Shop will determine the pairings. Players are expected to remain in their assigned groups as a courtesy to fellow members and in recognition of the Pro Shop's efforts in organizing pairings. For events where you can choose your partner or group, don't hesitate to sign up even if you don't have a partner—the Pro Shop will pair you accordingly.

The assignment of ABCD players is determined by the composition of league members playing each week. Please speak with the Morning League Chairperson or the Pro Shop staff if you have any questions.

There will be no split payouts for ties – all ties will be broken by the Pro Shop.

Max score on any given hole is 10.

EVENING LEAGUE

Play 9 holes.

Weekly sign up will be administered by the Pro Shop. You will receive an email to sign-up. Register by Wednesday at NOON. After 12:00, contact the Pro Shop directly if you need to cancel.

April – August: Announcements at 5:20, at your tee box at 5:30.

September: Announcements at 4:50, at your tee box at 5:00.

Guest night: July 29th. There will be a guest and member fee to include cart fees and dinner. Fees will be charged to the member's account.

For inclement weather, UNLESS the Pro Shop cancels, payouts will be made if at least two players show up and play at least 7 holes. For team events, at least two teams must play 7 holes. If play is cancelled, the payouts from that day will be set aside to distribute as payouts at some point during the rest of the season as determined by the committee.

Payouts are distributed weekly. The weekly amounts are budgeted based on the previous year's enrollment and may fluctuate depending on the actual number of participants.

Unless otherwise specified, the Pro Shop will determine the pairings. Players are expected to remain in their assigned groups as a courtesy to fellow members and in recognition of the Pro Shop's efforts in organizing pairings. For events where you can choose your partner or group, don't hesitate to sign up even if you don't have a partner—the Pro Shop will pair you accordingly.

The assignment of ABCD players is determined by the composition of league members playing each week. Please speak with the Pro Shop staff if you have any questions.

There will be no split payouts for ties – all ties will be broken by the Pro Shop.

TEAM PLAY FAQs

What is Team Play? Each club hosts all the member clubs on predetermined dates during the season. Each club sends 8 players who make up 4 teams of two in handicap order. On a given play day, each club will be playing another club that day for gross and net points. Each hole has both a gross and a net point to be won or lost, and ties result in a half point for each team. A club's cumulative points during the season determine the gross and net winner.

What are the benefits of participating in Team Play?

- The opportunity to play private clubs in the area that you might not otherwise get to play.
- The opportunity to meet ladies from other clubs who you might consider asking to our member/guest or to a league guest day. And you may be asked by them.
- Learning the rules and strategies of match play and how it differs from stroke play.
- The opportunity to get to know other BWGA members you might not normally play with.

Who is eligible to play? If you are a dues-paying member of The Bluffs in good standing and keep a handicap, you are eligible to sign up. While Team Play rules require each club to bring the lowest 8 handicaps who sign up, even if you carry a higher handicap, there's a good chance you will get to play at some point because there are times when lower handicaps are not available to play. There is no handicap index limit, but if you are higher than a 30 index, you are limited to a 30.

When do sign ups for Team Play dates occur? Team rosters are typically due to the hosting club approximately five days before each event. To allow enough time for planning, a notice will usually be sent about 10 days in advance asking players to indicate their availability for that event.

What does it cost to play? \$75 away and \$55 at home covers green fees, carts, and lunch.

How is it determined who I will play with? Teams must be paired in handicap order, so your group will consist of similar handicaps.

If I sign up to be on the Team Play roster, will I have to play every time? No. Even if you only expect to be able to play one time, sign up to be on the roster.

What if I don't play to my handicap? Won't I hurt the team if I have a high score? Contrary to common misconception, a handicap index does not represent the score you are expected to shoot every time; rather, it represents your demonstrated ability - in other words, what you are capable of shooting. The good news is in Team Play, you have a partner, and only one ball has to count for the gross or net point on any given hole. If you are having a bad hole, you can rely on your partner. Just do your best and have fun.

On what day of the week does Team Play occur? It varies but is always on a weekday vs. weekend. The most common days for Team Play to be scheduled are Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday. All the dates for the season are set at the beginning of the year, so you can look at the calendar to see when we are scheduled to play and where.

What is the start time? Do I have to stay for lunch? 8:30am shotgun start is the norm. Lunch is served immediately following play. You do not have to stay for lunch, but you will still be charged, as the \$75 is a flat fee for both golf and lunch at away clubs and \$55 at home. To go boxes may also be an option if you have to leave shortly after play.

Can I carpool with other team members? Yes. At nearly every play day, we will have at least one carpool.

WGAKC FAQs

What is WGAKC? The Women's Golf Association of Kansas City organized in 1915 for the purpose of stimulating interest in women's golf in the Kansas City area. It began with 5 clubs and today has 12.

What are the requirements to join? You must be a dues-paying member of The Bluffs in good standing, have a handicap index of 26.6 or below, and pay \$55 to join that goes toward payouts.

Who is eligible to play? Your handicap must be 26.6 or below to join. If you are not eligible at the beginning of the season but think you might become eligible during the season, you may join at any time you become eligible.

What is the format and how are the pairings done? With the exception of Opening and Closing Day, the format is stroke play with payouts for gross and net in each flight. Opening Day and Closing Day are A-B-C-D team events. Otherwise, pairings are with similar handicaps. There is also a "Two-Lady" tournament, where you pair up with a member of another club and play two days of golf, each at a different member club.

How is WGAKC different from Team Play? WGAKC is an individual competition among all members who sign up to play on a given day. Team Play is a competition between member clubs. In addition, WGAKC is stroke play, whereas Team Play is match play. Further, WGAKC has payouts, and Team Play does not. There is also no restriction on the number of players a club can bring.

If I sign up, will I be expected to play every time? No. You can play as many events as you decide to. A week or so prior to each play day, the Bluffs WGAKC representative (Bobbi Zink for 2026) will contact all WGAKC members from The Bluffs to ask if you are playing or not.

What are the benefits to joining WGAKC? The opportunity to play private clubs in the area that you might not otherwise get to play. The opportunity to meet ladies from other clubs who you might consider asking as a guest for our member/guest or to a league guest day. And you may be asked by them.

The opportunity to win gross and net payouts redeemable at any member club. Additional payouts for perfect attendance, most improved, club participation, among others.

What does it cost to play? \$75 at away clubs and \$55 at home which covers green fees, carts, and lunch.

On what day of the week does WGAKC occur? It varies. The most common days for WGAKC to be scheduled are Tuesday through Thursday.

What time is WGAKC usually played? Do I have to stay for lunch? 8:30am shotgun start is the norm. Lunch is served immediately following play. You do not have to stay for lunch, but you will still be charged, as the \$75 is a flat fee for both golf and lunch at away clubs and \$55 at home. To-go boxes may also be an option if you have to leave shortly after play.

Can I carpool with other team members? Yes. At most play days, we will have at least one carpool.

Fountain Cup FAQs

What is Fountain Cup? Fountain Cup was formed in 2024 as a friendly team competition among private clubs in the metro area. The inaugural four clubs are The Bluffs at The National, The National, Lakewood Oaks, and the Country Club of Leewood. For 2026, there are two new teams joining: Brookridge and Nicklaus Golf Club.

How is Fountain Cup different from Team Play? Fountain Cup matches involve 6 players selected at the Captain's discretion to play 3 matches with the other participating clubs on a home and away basis. Hosting clubs provide 3 tee times on a mutually agreed upon date. The 3 matches include a low handicap match, a mid-handicap match, and a high handicap match. Head-to-head match points are accumulated to determine seeding for the playoffs. The final two remaining teams then play for the championship match.

Team Play is also an interclub competition, but the format is different. In Team Play, clubs accumulate both gross and net points against other clubs during the season to determine a gross and net winner for the year. It's generally an 8:30 shotgun start, with all 8 of the participating clubs hosting once. Team Play takes 8 players per club participating, with pairings in handicap order.

For both formats, you play with a partner from your club.
