

FOUNTAIN CUP FAQs

What is Fountain Cup?

Fountain Cup was formed in 2024 as a friendly team competition among private clubs in the metro area. The inaugural four clubs are The Bluffs at The National, The National, Lakewood Oaks, and the Country Club of Leawood.

How is it different from Team Play?

Team Play is also a private interclub competition, but the format is different. Clubs accumulate both gross and net points against other clubs during the season to determine a gross and net winner for the year. Each Team Play is a shotgun with all 8 of the participating clubs being hosted at each of the clubs on 8 play dates. Team Play also has 8 players per team, and pairings are done in handicap order.

Fountain Cup has 6 players from each club selected at the Captain's discretion to play 3 matches with the 4 other participating clubs on a home and away basis. The 3 matches include a low handicap match, a mid-handicap match, and a high handicap match. Points are accumulated for the regular season matches to determine seeding for the playoffs. The two remaining teams will then play for the championship.
