## CITY OF ASHLAND OFFICIAL DOG LICENSE NOTICE

The City of Ashland requires the issuing of dog licenses to a person owning, keeping or harboring a dog over 6 months of age and within one month of acquisition. Licenses are then due on an annual basis each **MAY 1<sup>ST</sup>**. **Dog Licenses will not be issued without a copy of current rabies vaccinations.** Licenses must be renewed each year by May 31<sup>st</sup> or a late fee of \$5.00 per dog will be applied.

If you own, keep or harbor a dog you may purchase a license(s) in person Monday through Friday 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at City Hall, or by sending in the application below along with a photo copy of the rabies information and the appropriate fee to City Hall. Dog tags will be mailed to you. You may also make additional copies of this form if necessary.

If you have 3 dogs or keep a dog/s for breeding you must purchase a Kennel License. Kennel Licenses are not allowed in multi-family dwellings per zoning regulation section <u>8.09.01 Keeping of Animals</u> No more than two dogs per dwelling unit in duplex or multi-family buildings. Please contact the City office at 944-3387 or come in for more details.

**\$6-108 KUNNING AT LARGE (Leash Law)** It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog to allow such dog to run at large at any time within the corporate limits of the City. It shall be the duty of the City Police to cause any dog found to be running at large to be taken up and impounded. "Running at large" shall mean any dog found off the premises of the owner and not under control of the owner or a responsible person either by leash, cord, chain, wire, rope, cage or other suitable means of physical restraint.
