

How to make your plaster bat:

Using Potters Plaster to make your own 'clay reclaim plaster bat' is an easy, cost effective and repeatable process.

Our 'Plaster Bat Pack' is a great way to get started, just follow these easy steps:

- 1. Gather everything you need:
 - a) 4 bags of the Potters Plaster
 - b) 3300ml of water
 - c) Bat Mould
 - d) Measuring jug & mixing bucket
 - e) A non-detergent lubricant (i.e. kitchen spray oil, Vaseline, WD40)
 - f) Rib or spatula
- 2. Lightly grease the mould, like you would a cake tin.
- 3. Put the cold water in the bucket, then sprinkle the plaster evenly across the top of the water. Use your hand to mix the plaster into the water for a few minutes until you have a smooth consistency & most lumps have dissolved.
- **4.** Pour gently into the mould, then tap the sides on the mould so that any bubbles rise to the top.
- 5. Allow to dry for 45 minutes on a flat surface, or until it has become hard & warm to touch.
- 6. Gently flex the edges of the plastic mould to break any seal between the mould and the Plaster Bat. Turn onto its side & support the bat as you ease it out of the mould.
- 7. Use a rib/spatula/rub brick to smooth any sharp edges, rough bubbles or lumps from the bat, be careful as it will still be fragile at this stage.
- 8. Store on its side & allow it to thoroughly dry for a few days before use.

Make sure you clean up well to avoid any plaster contaminating your clay!
