









Electrical Connections:



- Single phase power is available in Australian and New Zealand homes.
- There are a variety of different plugs depending on the amount of current the device draws.
- 15, 20 and 25 amp sockets require installation by a registered electrician if not already installed.

Size	Plug Type	Socket Type	Kilns	Details
10 amps			FTS 1.0	Standard Household PowerPoint.
15 amps			FTS 1.5 FTS 1.5W	Larger neutral pin. Requires an upgraded PowerPoint by an electrician.
20 amps			FTS 2.2 FFL 1.7	Larger active and neutral pins. Requires an upgraded PowerPoint by an electrician.
25 amps			FTS 2.9 FTS 3.7 FFL 2.7 FFL 3.4	High amperage up to 32 amps. Requires an upgraded PowerPoint and review of electrical supply by an electrician.

AS/NZS 3112 is the harmonised Australian and New Zealand standard for AC power plugs (male) and sockets (female).
