May 9th, 2023, 17:00hrs

Pursuant to Section 12 (1) of the BC Emergency Program Act an **Evacuation Order** has been issued by the Village of Cache Creek due to the immediate danger to life safety caused by: flooding of the Bonaparte River.

Members of the RCMP and other applicable agencies will be expediting this action.


The Evacuation Order is in effect for the following areas:

YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Register at the ESS Reception Centre located at the McArthur Island Park 1655 Island Pkwy, Kamloops, BC V2B 6Y9 tel: 250-819-1752
- You may also register online at <https://ess.gov.bc.ca>
- **If you need transportation assistance from the area**, advise the person providing this notice, or call 250-457-9711 before 8:00PM May 9th.
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers.
- Close all windows and doors.
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.
- Take critical items: government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information if immediately available), and immediate care needs for dependents. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Further information will be issued as needed when the situation changes.
