School Back in Session = **KiDS**The Importance of Careful Driving

This is a special reminder that school is now back in session (as of last week) and to please pay special attention to the importance of careful driving when children may be present.

ground up—remember, children are shorter and smaller and may not be visible in a rear view mirror, especially if you sitting up high in an SUV or truck. Children can come out of nowhere on a bike or skateboard, so driving a little slower is advisable. KEEP KIDS SAFE!

Parking Fine\$



Most homeowners respect and appreciate the Villas' parking rules, but there are still a few who continue to violate them. The DCC&R Committee recently issued 3 parking violation fines @ \$50 each and the towing company was called to remove a vehicle. Please be aware that parking in the Matilda wash drain becomes a police matter since it is county-owned, which means the car will not only be towed at the owner's expense, but a hefty parking ticket too.

- The Rules & Regulations state HOMEOWNERS MUST park their cars in their garage. Homeowners should not park their vehicles in the temporary/guest parking lots unless it is for a brief period of time or some reasonable extenuating circumstance.
- Visitors are allowed to park in the temporary/visitor parking lots for a maximum of 3 days, unless they obtain a permit from the Board, otherwise they must park on Lessing Lane.
- Only authorized repair vendors may park along the curb or driveway apron for a short while.
- Please remember to keep your garage door closed when not entering and exiting your garage.
- HOA Fines are \$50 for the 1st offense and increase @\$25 for each additional violation thereafter.
- Towing is \$200 PLUS a \$20 per day storage fee (OUCH!)

So UNLESS YOU'RE RICH, the convenience of parking in these unauthorized areas is certainly **not worth the cost** of \$50-\$220+ to do so (especially when ample parking is just 100 yards away).
