Landscaping ~ Winter Schedule: Weekly maintenance done in 5 ongoing rotating sections:

- 1) Doria East end; 2) Doria West end; 3) Carolanne; 4) Joanna; 5) Matilda; (Hard pruning done December)
- Clearing vegetation, prickly pear and cholla cactus from common areas along Camino de Oeste & Lessing
- In between trimming maintaining vegetation of Common Area "A" (10 ft behind all 28 homes along Doria wash)
- Feb: Applying BLUE COLORED weed killer throughout the Villas. Please watch that your dogs don't walk on yards or on the common areas where weeds will be sprayed. Walking on street remains safe.



Parking Violations: October 2022: Vehicle belonging to renter was towed from Joanna Hammerhead after several parking violation notices and \$50 fine went ignored. **B&C towing** does random drive-thrus looking for vehicles parked in violation along the apron so please be



careful not to park along the apron. Contractors performing work who must temporarily park along the apron should post orange traffic cones around their vehicle to alert homeowners of their presence and to prevent their vehicle from being towed.

Please turn your outside light on at night or use automatic dusk to dawn bulbs for community lighting and safety; your light helps illuminate the street which helps others walk safely at night and also illuminates your house number which is critical for visibility for emergency vehicles and deliveries coming at night. **Dusk to Dawn bulbs**→ https://tinyurl.com/3yhz4vnc



Please keep garage doors closed (DCC&Rs, Section 2.08) "All garage doors of the dwelling units shall remain fully lowered and closed at all times unless the door is being used for purposes of ingress and egress." An open garage invites theft; and also snakes and other wildlife onto your property.



Prevent your delivery packages from being stolen by Porch Pirates: Have your packages left INSIDE your gate and keep a close eye on them.



Please keep your dog safely on leash and remember to clean up their waste. Small dogs off leash can fall prey to coyotes, hawks, bobcats, and other dogs who may appear suddenly without notice. Large dogs off leashes can also be dangerous or nuisances.



← Never dump paint water or chemicals onto street: Homeowners (or their contractors) who dump such substances will be charged \$ for the cost of having the damaged portion of street repaired, which is usually seal coating and MAKE SURE TO INFORM YOUR CONTRACTORS NOT TO RINSE PAINT BRUSHES ONTO OUR PRIVATE STREETS. We have no gutters and no drains so it doesn't wash away (SEE PHOTO).
