## Tent Inventory

Scout 4-person tents (1 for every 2 scouts): labeled 1401-4A, 1401-4B, etc.

Adult 5-person tents (1 for each adult): labeled 1401-5A, 1401-5B, etc.

Utility 6-person tent is labeled 1401-UA.

- Tent bags are labeled:
  - On the bottom in the white area and centered just below the name and description
  - On front of the big white tag in the upper left
- Tents are labeled in under the Alps Mountaineering Logo, centered under Mountaineering
- Flies are labeled on the small white tag on the backside near the Alps name
- Pole bags are labeled near the bottom edge
- Stake bags are labeled about 1" above the bottom edge
- Footprint bags are labeled centered just under the mountaineering and on the white tag
- Footprints are labeled on the small white tag
- Each tent should have 12 stakes and a "gear loft"
