Scout Basic Essentials	Long Pants
Pocket Knife or multitool <=3", folding, no fixed blades	T-shirts (1 per day + 1 extra for every 3)
Personal first aid kit	Long sleeve lightweight shirt
Rain Gear (jacket or poncho, optionally rain pants)	Sweatshirt or fleece
Water bottle / canteen (should be full)	Jacket
Flashlight / headlamp, Batteries, Spare bulb if not LED	Underwear (1 per day + 1 extra for every 3)
Matches / fire starter	Pajamas or Sweat Suit or Sleep Shirt
Sunscreen	Winter Clothing
Compass and map	Winter jacket
Permission Slip, Health Form A/B & C* and Insurance Card	Winter hat or balaclava (face mask)
Scout Spirit and Sense of Adventure	Gloves/mittens (1 or 2 pairs)
Camping Gear and Clothing	Long underwear top and bottoms (1 or 2 pairs)
Backpack or duffle bag	Warm socks - wool preferred (~2 pairs per day)
Backpack cover or large garbage bag	Winter Boots (in addition to other shoes)
Pillow or Stuff Sack	Items needed for Summer Camp are stored *
10 feet of cord	*Shower Shoes
Plate and Bowl or Mess Kit	*Swimsuit (one piece or 2-piece tankini, no bikinis)
Cup and/or coffee travel mug	*OA Sash if member
Knife, fork, spoon or Spork	*Merit Badge Books
Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Floss	Optional
Comb / Brush	Sunglasses and/or Sun hat or Ski Goggles in winter
Soap, shampoo	Fishing pole and tackle (license if required)
Deodorant	Cards, Book, other light games (ball, frisbee, etc.)
Towel and Washcloth	Water shoes / sandals
Feminine products	Camera
Scout Handbook	Watch (with alarm)
Paper, pencil, pen, notebook	Small day pack or School Backpack type bag
Insect repellent (no aerosol cans)	Whistle
Chapstick, Carmex, or Lip Balm etc.	Facial Tissue (Puffs/Kleenex) or Handkerchiefs
Sleeping bag - if it will be cold and bag is not rated for cold weather, one or 2 extra blankets may be needed	Other Toiletries - Hair Ties/Bands, Hair Products, QTips, Nail Clippers, Small Mirror
Insulating sleeping pad	Bandanna(s)
Prescription Medication (see med. policy)	Small Pillow
Garbage bag or laundry bag for dirty cloths etc.	Small camp chair or stool
Over-the-counter medication (see med. policy)	GPS
Scout Uniform, Uniform Hat, Neckerchief, Slide	Money for trading post or trip extras
Socks (1 pair/day + 2 or more extra for every 3)	Rain Hat
Camp Shoes / Tennis shoes (no open toe)	Dunk bag for mess kit
Boots / Shoes suitable for hiking	Trekking poles or hiking stick
Shorts (1 for every other day)	Small brush for brushing show off in winter
