Backpack or duffle bag	Sunglasses
Backpack cover or large garbage bag	Hat
Pillow or stuff sack	Hair ties/bands, hair products, small mirror
Sleeping bag rated for weather	Water shoes / sandals
Insulating foam or air sleeping pad	Camera
Plate and bowl or mess kit/dunk bag	Watch
Cup and/or travel mug	Small day pack bag
Knife, fork, spoon or spork	Paper, pencil, pen, notebook
Towel / washcloth	Bandana(s)
Feminine products	Small camp chair or stool
Garbage bag or laundry bag for dirty clothes	Trekking poles or hiking stick
CLOTHING	Money for trading post or trip extras
Sweatshirt/jacket or warm fleece	Fishing pole and tackle (license if required)
Long pants (or shorts with zip-off legs)	Cards, book, other light games (ball, frisbee, etc.)
Long sleeve lightweight shirt	
T-shirts (1 per day + 1 extra for every 3)	
Shorts (1 for every other day)	
Underwear (1 per day + 1 extra for every 3)	
Socks (1 pair/day + 1 or more extra for every 3)	
Pajamas	
Tennis shoes (no open toe)	
Boots / shoes suitable for hiking	Do not bring Video games, radios, phones (phone policy); Personal food—patrol to plan food & snacks

Fall/Winter/Spring Camping Gear Additions

CAMPING GEAR	OPTIONAL
Winter coat	Winter scarf or neck gaiter
Winter hat	Hand warmers
Winter gloves/mittens (1 or 2 pairs)	Fleece or down vest

Winter boots (in addition to other shoes)	Sled
Warm socks – wool preferred (2 pairs per day)	Snow shovel to build snow shelter
Long underwear top and bottoms (1 or 2 pairs)	Cross country skis, poles, boots
Snow pants or wool pants	Tarp to go under gear in tent
Sweater – preferably wool or heavy fleece	
Rain Gear (jacket and pants or poncho) if Fall or Spring	
OUTDOOR FALL/WINTER/SPRING CAMPING (NOT CABIN)	
Sleeping bag rated for 32 degrees, preferably 0 degrees	
Fleece sleeping bag liner or heavy blanket (if bag not rated for cold weather)	
Insulating Foam pad – air pads don't insulate
