Mason thrives on the energy of live performances. "The energy that I receive from the people watching me play, and seeing their smiles and enjoyment, is incredible," he says. For Mason, playing live is about creating memorable moments and sharing experiences that transcend

the music itself. "When I see the crowd reacting, singing along, and genuinely enjoying themselves, it fuels my passion even more."
