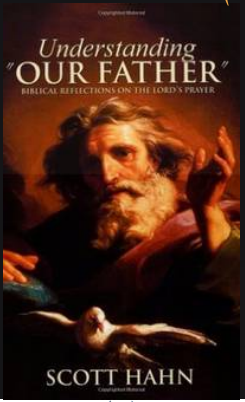
- Matthew 6:9-13
