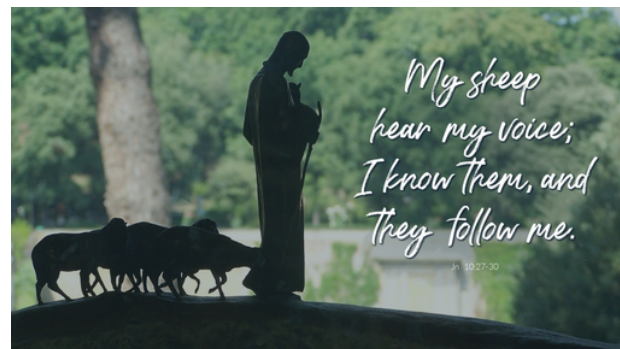

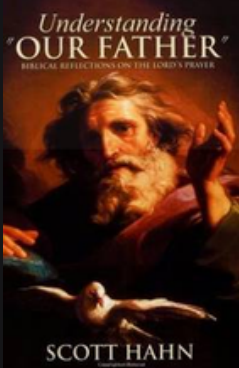
Understanding the prayer that Jesus taught his disciples; the same prayer most often prayed by Catholics and Christians throughout the world today.
