Degree Programs:

1. Bachelor of Theology (B.Th.)
Prerequisite: High school diploma or equivalent
2. Master of Arts in Jewish Studies (M.A.)
with Ono Academic College in Israel, Courses refer to Appendix A
Prerequisite: Bachelor or Associate (over 60 credit hours)
3. Master of Divinity (M.Div.)
Prerequisite: Bachelor's degree (A.B. or equivalent)
4. Master of Religious Education (MRE)
Prerequisite: Bachelor's degree or equivalent
5. Doctor of Ministry (D.Min)
Prerequisite: Master of Divinity (M.Div.) or Master of Religious Education (MRE) degree

Admission Requirements & Procedure

1. Submission of Application Form
2. All applicants must be baptized members of a recognized Christian denomination.
3. Submission of a written statement outlining the applicant's call to the Christian ministry.
4. Provision of a letter of reference from the applicant's local church minister.
5. Submission of academic transcripts.
 - A copy of the family register (birth certificate) is required.
6. Enrollment Fee: \$200

Following the admissions board's review of applications, selected applicants will be contacted to schedule an interview. Final admission decisions will be communicated within one week via email.

Graduation Requirements:

Bachelor of Theology Program:

Completion of 120 semester hours of coursework is required for graduation.

Master of Divinity & Master of Religious Education Programs:

Completion of 84 semester hours of coursework is required for graduation.

Doctor of Ministry Program:

Completion of 32 semester hours, including supervised Field Experience and a Project in Ministry, is required. This involves active engagement in ministry practice and theological reflection within the Christian church's response to human needs.

Kingdom International School (K.I.S.) delivers all courses through live Zoom sessions or recorded lessons accessible via the Canvas Learning Management System (L.M.S.). Each student is provided a personal Canvas account to engage with theological subjects and accumulate credits.

Textbooks are provided in PDF format or through links to online sellers. K.I.S. operates on a quarterly system, offering four semesters per year. Students have the opportunity to earn up to 21 credit hours per semester.

Typically, students complete subjects within 90 days of commencing a semester. However, should there be delays in completing required lessons, students must finalize all coursework within 120 days of beginning a class. Upon completion of each subject, students are required to submit a term paper.

Registration of Classes:

Students will consult an academic advisor to determine their course selections for the upcoming semester.

Program Length:

2-4 years, depending on the enrolled program.

Tuition:

\$150 per credit hour for the B.A. program

\$320 per credit hour for the M.A. M.Div, M.R.E, and D.Min programs

Scholarships:

1. Vision Scholarship: Awarded based on the submission of a self-introduction letter and ministry plan. Recipients receive \$1000.
2. Academic Scholarship: Awarded to students who achieve a GPA higher than 3.8/4.0 at the end of each semester. Recipients are granted a 50% reduction in tuition fees for the following academic semester.

Grading Policy:

Student evaluation will be based on attendance and assessment performance, with attendance comprising 60% and assessments 40% of the overall grade. Additionally, students are required to submit a final term paper.
