### ANNUAL MEETING 2026 – ELECTORAL ROLL

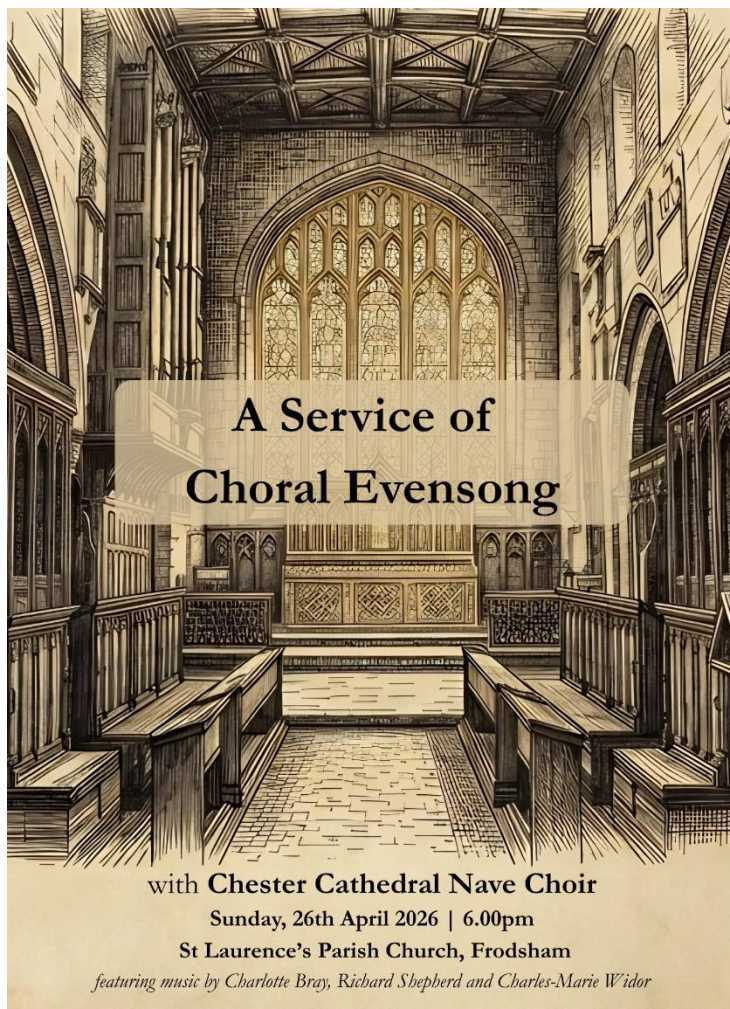

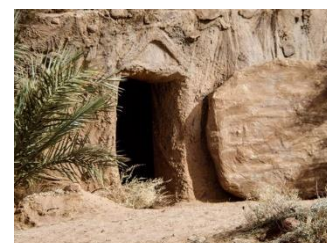
